

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Today, 7th June 2026 Shri Mukesh Singh, IPS, Director General of Police, Manipur, paid his maiden visit to Kangpokpi and Senapati districts. He was accompanied by Shri Lhari Dorjee Lhatoo, IPS, Additional Director General of Police (Law & Order), Manipur. During the visit, the DGP interacted with senior police officers and was briefed on the prevailing law and order situation, security measures, and key achievements of the police. He also reviewed the overall functioning and operational preparedness of the district police forces.
The DGP also held interactions with the district administration, commanders of the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs), and representatives of various Kuki civil society organisations—COTU, KIM, Kuki Inpi Sadar Hills, KWU, KSO Sadar Hills, Thadou Inpi Sadar Hills, TYA, and TWA—and Naga civil society organisations, namely the United Naga Council (UNC), Naga Women Union (NWU), All Naga Students' Association Manipur (ANSAM), Naga Peoples' Organisation (NPO), Senapati District Students' Association (SDSA), and Senapati District Women's Association (SDWA).
During the interactions, the DGP emphasized that the law applies equally to everyone and reaffirmed that the police will continue to serve the people impartially, without fear or favour. He appealed to the public to cooperate with the police in maintaining law and order and ensuring a safe and secure environment for all.
The visit was cordial and productive, further strengthening cooperation between the police, security forces, civil administration, and civil society towards ensuring lasting peace, security, and development in the districts and the state.
- III. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- IV. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 06.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (MFL) from Langdum Makha Leikai area under Irilbung-PS, Imphal East district namely, Ningthoujam Yamba Singh alias Boy alias Naocha alias Loijing alias Sanayamba (45) of Keirao Bitra Awang Leikai, Imphal East district. He was involved in extortion activities targeting the general public, private firms and government offices for raising party funds. From his possession, 01 (one) 9 mm Pistol along with magazine loaded with 04 (four) live rounds and one sling bag were seized.
- V. On 07.06.2026, Security forces arrested 02 (two) persons from T. Khullen naka post under Senapati-PS, Senapati district namely, (i) Man Bahadur Bhattarai (24) of Bajaghara village, Irang Part-II, Kangpokpi district and (ii) Co-driver Ajay Baniya (22) of Kharpani village, Irang Part-II, Kangpokpi district. From their possession, the following items were recovered:-
 - i. 28.190 kg of suspected opium,
 - ii. One bolero pickup vehicle b/ reg. no AS 05AC9494 along with key,
 - iii. One purse along with Rs. 5,000/- and some incriminating items.

- VI. On 07.06.2026, Manipur Police detained 01 (one) individual from Sekmaijing bridge area under Hiyanglam-PS, Kakching district namely, Salam Brojendro Singh (35) of Andro Kharam Leikai, Imphal East district.
From his possession, the following items were seized:
1. 01 (one) Urban Cruiser Taisor, Lucent Orange in colour car (MN06LX 7716) and
2. 250 litres of DIC Liquors.
- VII. On 07.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested 02 (two) persons from the Singngat-PS Check post under Singngat-PS, Churachandpur district. During the checking, 02 (two) persons namely:
i) K. Pauchinsuan (57) of CYA Road, Gouchinkhup Veng, New Lamka, Churachandpur A/p Mata Mualtam village, Churachandpur and
ii) Tuahmawi (42) of Mata Mualtam village, Churachandpur.
From their possession, the following items were seized:
i) 01 (one) four wheeler (Bolero vehicle bearing reg. number MZ01P8655,
ii) 107 soap cases weighing 5.143 kgs. including the weight of the plastic wrap and soap cases (approximately 1.4 kgs brown sugar) and incriminating items were seized.
- VIII. On 05.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested 02 (two) persons from a MVCP in Vajing village under Churachandpur-PS, Churachandpur district. They are identified as:
i) Mr. Paominthang Haokip (44) of Haika Village, Chandel district and
ii) Mr. Isla Uddin (37) of Kwakta Ward no. 8, Bishnupur district.
From their possession, 1.423 Kgs of suspected contraband items (brown sugar) were seized.
- IX. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
1. From 01.06.2026 to 07.06.2026, Manipur Police issued **74 (seventy four)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 1,31,500/- (one lakh thirty one thousand five hundred)**.
2. From 31.05.2026 to 06.06.2026, tinted films from **16 (sixteen)** vehicles were removed.
- X. A total of **114** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- XI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
