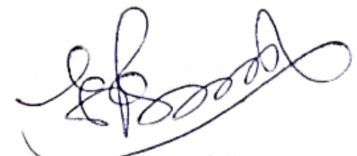
- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 07.07.2026, security forces recovered from general area of Tamei and adjoining areas along IT Road under Tamei-PS, Tamenglong district, the following:
 - i) 03 (three) Carbine machine guns, each with magazine,
 - ii) 02 (two) .32 pistols, each with magazine,
 - iii) 01 (one) AK 47,
 - iv) 03 (three) Lathod guns,
 - v) 02 (two) Barrel loaded guns,
 - vi) 82 (eighty two) live rounds and
 - vii) 01 (one) BP Jacket.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 06.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (Nongdrenkhomba), one Moirangthem Thoiba Singh (30) of Sugnu Makha Leikai from his locality under Sugnu-PS, Kakching district.
 2. On 06.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of PLA/RPF, one Keisham Kenedy Singh alias Roger (38) of Utlou Mamang Keisham Leikai, Bishnupur district from Utlou area under Nambol-PS.
 3. On 06.07.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist active cadre of KNF, one Md. Abdulla Hussain (22) of Mullargao, Jiribam district from Nungkhal Bridge area under Jiribam-PS, Jiribam district. A country made .32 pistol with magazine, and 06 (six) live rounds were seized from him.
 4. On 07.07.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist, one Ningthoujam Roshan Singh (29) of Tairenpokpi Awang Leikai, Imphal West district from his residence under Lamsang-PS. The arrestee was extorting money from certain vehicles passing through his locality.
- IV. On 06.07.2026, Manipur Police recovered 17 packets of suspected Ganja weighing approximately 221 kg from Pungdongbam Awang Leikai under Lamlai-PS, Imphal East district.
- V. The Director General of Police, Manipur, Shri Mukesh Singh, IPS, accompanied by the ADG (L&O), IG, and other senior officers, visited Noney District Police Headquarters today to review the prevailing law and order, crime, and operational situation.

During the review, the DGP emphasized maintaining law and order, strengthening anti-extortion operations, and ensuring prompt investigation and disposal of pending cases through quality investigation. He urged officers to remain proactive in curbing extortion activities.

The DGP also visited the CRPF camp at Lamdangmei to assess the security situation in the fringe areas and chaired a coordination meeting with Commanding Officers of the CAPFs deployed in the district. Special emphasis was laid on ensuring adequate security for the movement of essential commodities along NH-37.

Later, the DGP interacted with civil society leaders of Noney, assured full cooperation from the district police, and appealed for continued public support in maintaining law and order and fostering lasting peace.

- VI. Movement of **150** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VII. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VIII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- 9233522822 of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
