

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 8th June, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. On 08.06.2026, security forces arrested 02 (two) residents of Assam along with suspected contraband items from T. Khullen Naka Post under Senapati-PS, Senapati district:
 - i. Nasimuddin (38) of Uriamghat, Devipur, and
 - ii. Monjit (25) of Gomariguri.From their possession, inter alia, the following were seized:
 - i. 12 soap cases of suspected Brown Sugar,
 - ii. One Grand I 10 vehicle (AS 01LC9436), from which the contraband items were recovered,
 - iii. Cash amount of Rs. 4,000/-.
- IV. On 08.06.2026, security forces arrested one Nongmaithem Rupu Singh (38) of Sapam Mamang Leikai, Thoubal district along with suspected contraband items from Keithelmanbi area under New keithelmabi-PS, Imphal West district.
From his possession, inter alia, the following were seized:
 - i. 05 (five) soap cases of Heroin Powder weighing 58 grams,
 - ii. A TATA Tanker Bullet.
- V. Movement of **130** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. A total of **114** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
