12. First Information Contents:

On 22/07/2026 at about 09:30 A.m., reliable information was received that some unknown miscreant/suspected undergrounds (UG) cadres had blown up the PMGSY bailey bridge over Namban Lok river, situated between Phange and Chatric village, by using Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs). The said Bridge is only means of connectivity between Chatric and its surrounding villages with the District Headquarters.

It was further reported that a Bolero vehicle belonging to the Telecom Department, which was parked on the bank of the Namban Lok river was also set on fire and burnt by the unknown miscreants.

The above act appears to have been committed deliberately and with the intention of causing extensive damage to public property and critical infrastructure, disrupting essential transportation and communication services, obstructing public movement and creating fear and insecurity among the general public. The incident also amounts to an unlawful act endangering public safety and affecting the security of the state.

Hence, a Suo-Moto case has been registered vide FIR No. 12(7)2026/CSD-PS U/s 3 (5)/324 (5)/326(g)/61(2) of BNS,2023 & 3 and 4 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908 for investigation
