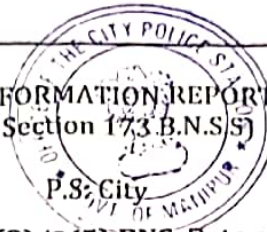

Subject: Complaint for registration of FIR against Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi, wife of O. Loken Singh of Building No. 0386 of Thangal Bazar, Imphal West, an unidentified woman in red phanek, and armed security personnel for criminal intimidation, death threat, communal incitement, abuse of uniform, and related offences

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Arihant Kumar Patni, resident of 69 Thangal Bazaar, Imphal West, Manipur, am submitting this written complaint for registration of an FIR regarding the incident that occurred on 9 June 2026 outside my store, M/S Sanmati Traders, Thangal Bazaar, Imphal.

On the said date around 3:00 pm while I was walking outside the store area, there was a minor and accidental shoulder contact between me and Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi, wife of O. Loken Singh of Building No. 0386 of Thangal Bazar, Imphal West. The said contact happened without any bad intention and was not an intentional touch, especially because the area is a small Galli and a narrow path where people are naturally required to pass closely.

I did not abuse, provoke, or retaliate. I attempted to avoid the situation and move away.

However, Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi became aggressive and started verbally and physically confronting me. The matter was thereafter escalated by her and by persons accompanying her.

During the incident, an unidentified civilian woman wearing a red phanek joined Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi and appeared to provoke the surrounding public by making statements and gestures capable of creating hostility and communal tension against me and my family. The conduct was dangerous because the incident occurred in a crowded public market area and had the potential to disturb public peace.

The armed security personnel deployed with Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi did not perform their duty of de-escalation or removal of their protectee from the area. Instead, they actively shielded her conduct and contributed to the intimidation.

Many of the armed CRPF/VVIP security personnel, including two wearing a Blue Safari dress, were the head or leading figures among the security guards present, while others appeared to be in uniform. They played the main role in escalating the matter. They abused the power of their uniform, acted beyond their lawful duty, and tried to incite and inflame communal sentiments instead of controlling the situation. The conduct of all security personnel present showed a clear abuse of the power of their uniform.

One of the armed CRPF personnel directly threatened my life by stating words to the effect that he would get his team to "drag me out and shoot me."

This was a clear death threat issued by an armed uniformed personnel against an unarmed civilian. I genuinely fear for my life and safety, as well as the safety of my family, staff, and business premises.

The incident has been captured on CCTV cameras installed at and around our business premises. The CCTV footage contains both video and audio evidence, including the conduct of Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi, the unidentified woman, the armed security personnel, the Blue Safari security personnel, the communal provocation, and the threat issued against me.

If all the videos and CCTV footage are watched carefully, the matter is self-explanatory. It clearly reflects a life-threatening situation, instigation of communal flare-up, and blatant abuse of uniform and authority by the security personnel.

I am not mentioning any specific legal section in this complaint, as it is the duty of the police authority and the investigating officer to apply the correct legal provisions based on the facts, evidence, CCTV footage, audio, witness statements, and investigation.

On the basis of the above facts, I request you to register an FIR against:

1. Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi, wife of O. Loken Singh of Building No. 0386 of Thangal Bazar, Imphal West.
2. The unidentified woman wearing a red phanek.
3. The CRPF/security personnel visible in the CCTV footage and deployed with Haobam (N) Irom (O) Chitra Devi.
4. The armed CRPF/VVIP security personnel wearing Blue Safari dress, who appeared to be leading the security guards and played the main role in escalating the situation.
5. Any other person found involved during investigation.

I request that the matter be investigated from the angle of criminal intimidation, death threat, communal provocation, abuse of uniform, misuse of armed security cover, unlawful intimidation of civilians, and common involvement of all persons who participated in or enabled the incident.

I further request that immediate police protection be provided to me and my family, as the threat was issued by an armed security personnel and the accused persons have influence and security cover.

Kindly register the FIR, provide me with the FIR number, and take immediate legal action.

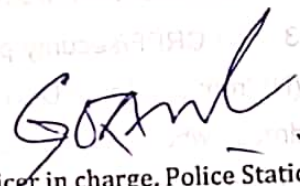
