Sub: Report

Sir,

Today, i.e., 02/07/2026, at about 12:25 PM, reliable source information was received regarding movement of illegal contraband substances at Mualkoi Village, Churachandpur. Acting promptly on the said information, a police team from Churachandpur Police Station, including Women Police personnel, under the command of Shri Jay Barange, IPS, SDPO/Churachandpur, proceeded to the suspected house and conducted a search in the presence of the Executive Magistrate.

During the house search, 17 (seventeen) packets containing suspected brown sugar, packed inside a white sack, were recovered from the living room of the house. Two persons present in the house identified themselves as Mr. Liankhanthang, (owner of the house) and Mrs. Zamngaihlian Tombing (45 years), W/o Thangzakap Tombing, resident of Zion Veng, New Lamka, Churachandpur.

On being questioned, Mrs. Zamngaihlian Tombing disclosed that the recovered contraband substances had been delivered to her by Ms. Niangngaihching (43 years) D/o Late Chinkhenpau, a native of Haichin Village, Myanmar, presently residing at Pangzawl, Churachandpur.



Based on the disclosure made by Mrs. Zamngaihlian Tombing, the police team immediately proceeded to the residence of Ms. Niangngaihching and conducted a search. During the search, Indian currency amounting to ₹31,43,600/- (Rupees Thirty-one lakh forty-three thousand six hundred only), suspected to be proceeds of illicit drug trafficking, was recovered from her house.

On further enquiry, Ms. Niangngaihching disclosed the involvement of another associate, namely Mr. Mangnunsang Tawtak (36 years), S/o T.S. Khamzakhup, also a resident of Pangzawl. Acting on this information, the police team immediately proceeded to his residence, apprehended him, along with recovered one money-counting machine and One Bolero (White Colour) bearing Registration Number MN 06 LX 5142 from his house.

Considering the prevailing security situation, all the recovered contraband substances, cash, mobile phones, money-counting machine, One Bolero Vehicle and the three accused persons were brought to Churachandpur Police Station for detailed search, seizure, weighing, counting, and other legal formalities in the presence of the Executive Magistrate, Mr. Satkhogin Kilong, SDC/Churachandpur.

Upon detailed examination at the police station, the 17 packets were found to contain a total of 186 soap cases of suspected brown sugar weighing 2.413 Kilograms. The recovered cash was counted and found to be ₹31,43,600/-. Accordingly, the contraband substances, recovered money, three phone of the accused, the money counting machine and One Bolero Vehicle were seized under proper seizure memo in the presence of the Executive Magistrate and independent witnesses at Churachandpur Police Station on 02/07/2026 at 5:21 PM.

The three accused persons were formally arrested at CCP-PS at 6:00 PM on 02/07/2026:

- 1) Mrs. Zamngaihlian Tombing (45 years) W/o Thangzakap Tombing, resident of Zion Veng, New Lamka, Churachandpur.
- 2) Ms. Niangngaihching (43 years) D/o Late Chinkhenpau, native of Haichin Village, Myanmar, presently residing at Pangzawl, Churachandpur.
- 3) Mr. Mangnunsang Tawtak (36 years) S/o T.S. Khamzakhup, resident of Pangzawl, Churachandpur.

The three accused persons, along with the seized contraband substances, recovered cash, three mobile phones, one money-counting machine and One Bolero alongwith key have been handed over to you for registration of a case and further necessary action in accordance with law.

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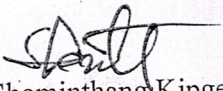
