Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that, today i.e., 12/06/2026 at about 11.30 pm, when I was at NAB-PS, Manipur one of my source man informed me that 1 (one) person, namely Dil Bahadur Chetry 41 yrs of Tinsukia, Assam were carrying a huge quantity of WY tablets and is planning to leave Imphal through winger from North AOC to Dimapur. The said information was reduced in writing and placed before the Superintendent of Police/NAB, Manipur. Then, I along with a team of NAB-PS, Manipur and all the necessary equipment were constituted for execution of the secret information.

A team of NAB-PS, Manipur moved towards Winger Parking, North AOC area of Imphal West District, Manipur in the departmental vehicle TATA Yodha of NAB-PS, Manipur regd. No. NH along with necessary equipment and documents for looking the same person. On reaching the said spot and indicated by the source man, the team of NAB-PS, Manipur found one persons in suspicious manner carrying a blue back-pack bag labelled as SOBERS on the road side of Winger Parking, North AOC near Public Toilet, Imphal West District, Manipur. Accordingly, after identifying ourselves as the police officer and personnel of NAB-PS, Manipur he was stop at the spot for verification and checking. On asking, he told the police team that, he is carrying narcotics drug tablets which is kept concealed inside his pocket and he was detained at the spot for verification and checking.

I requested nearby civilian to witness the search, seizure and arrest procedure and no civilians agreed to witness the same. Simultaneously, two personnel from my team namely C/ No. 1804005 Mayanglambam Rohini Kumar 29 yrs s/o M. Indrakumar of Itham Nungei Khunou, II District, Manipur and Phurailatpam Angamba Singh 46 yrs s/o Ph. Deveshor Sharma of Uripok Huidom Leikai, Imphal West District, Manipur voluntarily agreed to witness the same. At the meantime, a requisition was submitted to Scientific Officer, Mobile Forensic Unit, Lamphel, Imphal West for deputing a team of Mobile Forensic Unit. As requisite, the team of MFU, IW District led by Ningombam Sashibala Devi, Scientific Assistant were reached at the spot.

In presence of the witness, the detainee were identified himself as **Dil Bahadur Chetry 41 yrs s/o Bal Bahadur Chetry of Vill- Shantipur No.04, PO-Shantipur, PS- Chapakhowa (Sadiya), District - Tinsukia Assam A/P-Changlang Bordumsa, Arunachal Pradesh.** Further, I briefed about the provisions of section 50 NDPS Act, 1985 in hindi language to the

detainee and were informed that they have legal right u/s 50 NDPS Act to be searched his body and belongings before Magistrate/Gazetted Officer or Civil/Independent witnesses, if they so desired. A notice u/s 50 NDPS Act was served to him in which he opted to be search before civil witnesses.

Further, in presence of the witness, the team of Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West District, Manipur and the team of NAB-PS, Manipur started conducting legal procedures. On checking the body of the detainee, he himself produced a bundle wrapped with transparent cello tap suspected to containing WY Tablet which was kept concealed in his right side pant pocket. Accordingly, the bundle wrapped with transparent cello tap suspected to containing WY Tablet was marked as "A" for identification. On cutting and opening "A", found another two bundles wrapped with light brown paper and transparent plastic polythene tight with rubber band. The two bundles were marked as "A1" and "A2" for identification. On opening "A1" and "A2", each bundle found containing 10 (ten) Nos. pouches black plastic polythene (in total 20 nos. pouches. On opening a pouch from each bundle found 200 Nos. of pinkish colour suspected to be WY tablet. The Mobile Forensic Unit, Imphal West District, Manipur took one tablet from each bundle i.e A1 & A2 for field testing by using field testing kits brought by them. **The test gave positive response of Methamphetamine.** On weighing, each bundle i.e "A1" and "A2" weighed 206 grams of WY (Methamphetamine) tablet (total 412 grams) including the weight of the plastic pouches. After weighing, each 10 (ten) Nos. pouch black plastic polythene were wrapped with its original light brown paper marked as "A1" and "A2" which were again bind with rubber band. "A1" & "A2" containing 206 grams of WY (Methamphetamine) tablet (total 412 grams) including the weight of the plastic pouches and one plastic cello tap marked as "A" (sorted packing material) were put in a big yellow paper envelope marked "B" which was properly packed and sealed with wax by using the facsimile of O.C. NAB PS, Manipur.

In presence of the witnesses, one yellow paper envelope which was properly packed and sealed with wax marked as "B" containing two bundles marked "A1" & "A2" containing 206 grams of WY (Methamphetamine) tablet (total 412 grams) including the weight of the plastic pouches and one plastic cello tap were seized from the possession of **Dil Bahadur Chetry 41 yrs s/o Bal Bahadur Chetry of 4 No. Shantipur, District - Tinsukia, PS- Chapakhowa (Sadiya), Assam** at the spot on the same day at 1.25 pm by preparing a weighing and seizure memo.

Further, 1) One blue back pack bag labelled SOBERS marked as "C", 2) One mobile phone Realme C15 bearing mobile No. +91 6204197769 silver in colour, 3) One laptop Lenovo black in colour along with charger, keyboard and mouse, 4) One wallet brown in colour, 5) Rs. 420/- (Indian currency), 6) One Aadhaar Card, 7) One PNB Debit Card, 8) One SBI Debit Card and 9) One National ID Card Govt. of Nepal were seized from the production of **Dil Bahadur Chetry 41 yrs s/o Bal Bahadur Chetry of 4 No. Shantipur, District - Tinsukia, PS-**

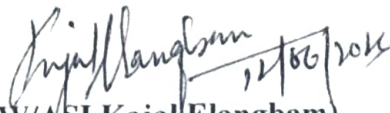
Chapakhowa (Sadiya), Assam at the spot on the same day at 1.30 pm by preparing a seizure memo. Accordingly, he was arrested at 01:35 p.m by preparing arrest memo.

The whole process of search and seizure was videographed in my eSakshya account. I took the signatures of the arrested accused person and witnesses in the parent exhibits marked as B, weighing and seizure memo, seizure memo and arrest memo and I also put my signatures on the same. I gave intimation about the arrest to his wife, namely, Binita Chetry through mobile phone bearing No. 09395167573 and gave information about the ground of arrest to the arrested accused person.

Hence, the arrested accused person along with the seized items are handed over to you for taking necessary actions.
