Subject: Request for registration of a regular FIR.

Sir,

I respectfully submit that, during the course of enquiry into the unnatural death of Swami Sapam @ Nabadip, aged about 26 years, S/o S. Khomei Singh of Leishangthem Kelimakhong, whose dead body was recovered on 05.07.2026 at about 5:35 AM from the eastern roadside of Khekman Ningthibi Khongbal Canal, vide UD Case No. 2/TBL-PS/2026 dated 05/07/2026 U/s 194 BNSS, sufficient materials have emerged disclosing the commission of cognizable offences.

The place where the dead body was found was visited, and a thorough spot investigation was conducted. The scene of occurrence was examined with the assistance of the Mobile Forensic Unit (MFU), Thoubal. During the inspection, one Realme mobile phone and one 0.5 ml syringe were recovered from the possession of the deceased and seized in accordance with law. Further, a blood sample was collected from the crime scene with the assistance of MFU, Thoubal and placed in a brown envelope marked as "B" and accordingly seized. A rough sketch map of the place of occurrence along with an index was also prepared.

During the course of the inquiry, it was noticed that the deceased had a needle puncture mark on his right hand. Coupled with the recovery of the used syringe from his possession, the circumstances indicated that the deceased had been administered a substance by injection prior to his death. The dead body was subjected to a Magisterial Inquest and post-mortem examination on 05/07/2026 at the Department of Forensic Medicine, JNIMS, Porompat, in the presence of the Executive Magistrate, and the entire proceedings were videographed. However, the family members refused to receive the dead body, alleging that the death was suspicious and insisting that the actual cause and circumstances of the death be established. As so, the dead body is still lying in the deep-freezer cold storage of the JNIMS Mortuary, Porompat, on police requisition. The post-mortem examination report and the Crime Scene Investigation Report of the Mobile Forensic Unit, Thoubal, are still awaited.

During the enquiry, statements of witnesses were recorded, technical evidence including Call Detail Records (CDRs) was analysed, and CCTV footage collected from different locations was examined. On the basis of the statements of witnesses, the surrounding circumstances, and other materials collected during the enquiry, it has emerged that the deceased is suspected to have been administered a narcotic drug by injection at the house of Md. Majahar aged about 60 years S/o Late Md. Manouwar of Lilong Dolaithabi Khongbal resulting in a suspected overdose in the intervening night of 4/7/2026 and 5/7/2026.

The enquiry has further revealed that, instead of providing immediate medical treatment to the deceased or informing the police, Majahar allegedly contacted his younger brother Md. Rafi @ Rafijuddin aged about 53 years. Thereafter, Majahar, Rafi, Md. Amir @ Boboy aged about 30 years s/o Md. Habibur Rahaman of Lilong Chingjao and their associates are suspected to have transported the dead body from the actual place of occurrence and abandoned it at Khekman Ningthibi Khongbal under Thoubal Police Station with the intention of concealing the actual place and circumstances of the occurrence and screening themselves from legal punishment.

In view of the facts stated above, the available evidence and materials collected during the course of the inquiry prima facie disclose the commission of cognizable offences punishable U/s 105/238/3(5) BNS, 2023.

It is therefore, a regular FIR may kindly be registered against Majahar, Rafi @ Rafijuddin, Md. Amir @ Boboy and other unknown associates U/s 105/238/3(5) BNS, 2023, and that investigation be taken up in accordance with law.
