13. First Information contents:

Brief of the case:

On, 14.07.2026, a complaint report was lodged at Porompat Police Station by the complainant Naib Subedar G R Soren, Platoon Commander of 8th Batallion Bihar Regiment stating that during a cordon-and-search operation conducted by their unit in the general area of Sikibung, under the jurisdiction of Litan Police Station, Ukhrul District, acting on specific and reliable information, four persons were apprehended between 09:21 hrs and 09:35 hrs.

The apprehended persons were identified as;

1. Wungphayo Kasar, 24 yrs., S/o Unison Kasar,
2. Ninglum Awungshi, 26 yrs., S/o Somiwon,
3. Lunglung Yaoreingam, 21 yrs., S/o Lungleng Makanmi, and
4. Vareiyoy Lunglen, 57 yrs., S/o Shimsreishang Lungleng,

All are residents of Sikibung (Sharkaphung) Village, Ukhrul District. During the search, one SBBL gun (No. T16012.9), one box of flat-head pellets, one SBBL gun (No. 55600-12), five live SBBL cartridges, one Motorola/Baofeng wireless set, and three Redmi mobile phones were recovered from their possession. The recovered articles were seized under proper seizure memos.

The formalities prescribed under the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) could not be completed at the place of occurrence due to the sudden gathering of an irate mob protesting the arrest of the individuals. In view of the prevailing law and order situation, the apprehended persons along with the seized articles were safely brought to the Police Station for further legal action.

During preliminary questioning, Wungphayo Kasar, Ninglum Awungshi and Lunglung Yaoreingam claimed to be cadres of NSCN (IM), while Vareiyu Lunglen claimed to be a supporter/associate of the organisation. The recovered arms and ammunition were found outside any designated ceasefire camp. None of the apprehended persons possessed a valid identity card issued under the Ceasefire Ground Rules authorising them to carry arms, nor had any prior intimation of armed movement been given to the security forces. Their possession of the recovered arms and ammunition was therefore found to be unauthorised and unlawful.

As the Place of Occurrence falls under the jurisdiction of Litan Police Station, the case was transferred to Litan-PS on 15/07/2026 for further investigation. Hence the case.

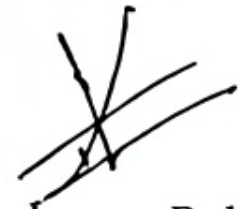

Subject: Written complaint under Section 173 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for registration of a First Information Report against four (04) apprehended armed individuals and for taking up investigation in accordance with law.

Sir / Madam,

1. I, **Naib Subedar G R Soren**, Platoon Commander of 8th Battalion Bihar Regiment am competent and authorised to lodge this written complaint on behalf of the security force party detailed for operations in the said area. The facts stated herein are within my personal knowledge and/or based on the report of the members of the apprehending party.
2. In the course of a **cordon-and-search operation** conducted by a party of this Unit in the general area of **Sikibung**, under the jurisdiction of Litan PS, Ukhrul District and while acting on **specific and reliable information**, the security force party intercepted and apprehended four (04) individuals on **14 July 2026** at approximately **09:20 am** onwards i.e Wungphayo Kasar at 09:21 am alongwithr one single barrel mark as T16012.9, 1 Box of flat head basic pellete and one Redmi Note 13 (IMEI- 866083068792000) mobile was seized from his possession by preparing a seizure memo dated 14/07/2026 @ 09:23 am later his co associates namely Ninglum was also arrested at 09:25 am alongwith one Redmi Note 13 (IMEI- 864328079284386) mobile, Lunglung Yoreingam at 09:30 am along with one single barrel marked as 55600-12 , 05 live rounds of sbbl, 01 Motorola set marked as BAOFENG and one Redmi note 7 (IMEI- 868330043263393) mobile was also seized accordingly by preparing a seizure memo dated 14/07/2026 @ 09:32 am and Vareiyio at 09:35 am at **Sikibung Hills**. The necessary formalities according to BNSS could not be carried out due the arrest of following individuals during search and seizure resulted in irate mob regarding the arrest, so i alongwith my team managed to report at PRT-PS for further necessary action.
3. On being challenged and searched the said individuals were found to be in unauthorised possession of the arms and ammunition. The arms and ammunition so recovered have been seized under proper memo, sealed, and are being handed over herewith.
4. On preliminary questioning, three (03) of the apprehended individuals disclosed that they are cadres of the NSCN (IM), and the fourth disclosed that he is a supporter / associate of the said organisation. Their particulars, as ascertained, are given at Table 'A' below:

5. It is respectfully brought to your notice that:

- (a) The recovery of the said arms and ammunition was effected **outside any camp designated under the Ceasefire Ground Rules**;
- (b) **None** of the apprehended individuals was in possession of a valid photo identity card issued under the Ceasefire Monitoring machinery (CFMG / CFSB) authorising movement with arms; and
- (c) **No prior intimation** of any armed movement had been given to the security forces as required under the Ceasefire Ground Rules.

The apprehended individuals are therefore not entitled to the protection of the ceasefire, and their possession and carriage of the said arms and ammunition is unauthorised and unlawful.

6. The acts and conduct of the apprehended individuals, as described above, **prima facie** disclose the commission of cognizable offences punishable, inter alia, under Sections 147/148/149/ 150/152 read with Sections 61(2) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959; and in respect of the fourth individual, the abetment provisions under Sections 45 and 49 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. *[If any recovered weapon/ammunition is of prohibited bore or class, add Section 7 read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959; if grenades/TEDs/explosive material are recovered, add Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908.]*

7. The four (04) apprehended individuals, together with the arms and ammunition recovered from their possession and the connected seizure / apprehension documents, are hereby produced and handed over to your Police Station for registration of a First Information Report and for taking up investigation in accordance with law.

8. It is accordingly requested that:

- (a) A First Information Report be registered on the basis of this complaint under Section 173 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, under the sections of law stated above and any other section found attracted on investigation;
- (b) Investigation be taken up expeditiously and the apprehended individuals dealt with in accordance with law; and
- (c) As the offences under Chapter VII of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 require the previous sanction of the Central Government or the State Government under Section 217 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 before cognizance, the proposal for such sanction be initiated in due course through the competent authority.
