

PRESS NOTE  
Imphal, the 11<sup>th</sup> July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. On 10.07.2026, Manipur Police apprehended a person in connection with an NDPS related FIR case registered in Haryana, one Dipu Gupta from Churachandpur along with a sum of Rs. 29,42,400/- suspected to be proceeds of drug crimes.

The arrestee who was suspected to be involved in hawala transactions for drug lords in Churachandpur district has been handed over to Haryana Police along with the recovered crime proceeds.

- IV. On 11.07.2026, Manipur Police intercepted a grey Tata Punch (MN-04P-4706) at Kwakta area, Bishnupur district and arrested its occupant one Md. Amzad Khan (47) of Lilong Chingjao along with approximately 5 kgs of Brown Sugar and cash amount of ₹83,770.
- V. Movement of **300** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. A total of **110** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
