

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 22nd July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 22.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of RPF/PLA, an extortionist and recruiter, one Samurailakpam Sanjit Sharma of Kalinagar, Jiribam, a/p Heingang, Imphal East from Bakhal area of Cachar district, Assam.
- IV. On 22.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested one, Mrs. Tinnei Thadou (52) of Lonpi Khonou, Sugnu, Chandel district from Songja Khopi village area of Churachandpur along with approximately 1.6 kgs of suspected Brown Sugar.
- V. On 22.07.2026, during an anti-narcotics operation in and around Mantripukhri Bazar, security forces seized 3.66 kg of suspected opium and arrested the following:
 - i). Anil Das (75) originally of Belghati, presently residing at Mantripukhri,
 - ii). Roshan Basnet (48) of Kanglatongbi Hathikhuwa, and
 - iii). Goma Karki (33) of Kanglatongbi Hathikhuwa.
- VI. During a raid on 22.07.2026, a joint team of Manipur Police and NCB arrested one Nengjatuan alias Tuanpi from Hotel Venus, Churachandpur. The arrested individual is alleged to be a major drug supplier and is wanted in multiple NDPS cases registered with NCB, DRI and Manipur Police.
- VII. Movement of **564** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VIII. A total of **112** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- IX. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
