- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts:
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 25.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (City Meitei), one Urikhinbam Malemnganba Singh alias Watemba (30) of Sorok Atingbi Khunou, Hilghat, Jiribam district from Thongju Part-II area under Singjamei-PS.
- IV. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
 1. From 20.07.2026 to 26.07.2026, Manipur Police issued **182 (one hundred eighty two)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 2,27,000/- (two lakh twenty seven thousand) only**.
 2. From 20.07.2026 to 26.07.2026, tinted films from **57 (fifty seven)** vehicles were removed and **02 (two)** vehicles were seized.
- V. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
