

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 30th July, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 29.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an active cadre of KCP (MFL), one Maibam Rajkumar Singh alias Chinkang (28) of Tentha Mathak Leikai from Khongjom area along NH-02 under Khongjom-PS, Thoubal district.
 2. On 29.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (Nongdrenkhomba), one Leishangthem Lamnganba Singh alias Nungsiba alias Naoba (23) of Thangmeiband Polem Leikai under Imphal-PS, Imphal West district from his residence.
 3. On 30/07/2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of KYKL, one Mangkhom Keshokumar Singh (45) alias Ibungo of Kongba Makha Nandeibam Leikai, Imphal East district from the vicinity of RIMS under Lamphel-PS, Imphal West district.
- IV. On 30.07.2026, security forces intercepted at T-Khullen Check Post under Senapati-PS, Senapati district, a White Bolero (NL07CC-2510) and arrested its occupant, one Alal Uddin (33) of Morigaon district, Assam along with 1.120 kg of suspected heroin, and ₹5,000 cash.
- V. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
