

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 3rd June, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery arms and ammunition:
 1. On 03.06.2026, security forces recovered from a hut at Irilbung area under Irilbung-PS, Imphal East district, the following:
 - i) 02 (two) nos. of AK Rifles,
 - ii) 01 (one) no. of SLR Rifle,
 - iii) 01 (one) no. of 9 mm Carbine,
 - iv) 04 (four) nos. of hand grenades,
 - v) 02 (two) nos. of AK Rifle magazines,
 - vi) 01 (one) no. of SLR magazine and
 - vii) 42 (forty two) nos. of different calibers.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 02.06.2026, security forces apprehended 04 (four) VBIG active cadres of KCP, KYKL and PREPAK from the general area of BP 67 near Khangtung village under Molcham-PS, Chandel district. They are identified as:
 - i) Mayanglambam Gandhi Singh (24) of Ningthoukhong, Shantipur, Ward No. 2, Bishnupur (KCP),
 - ii) Langpoklakpam Sushil Singh (25) of Khongjom, Tekcham, Thoubal (PREPAK).
 - iii) Laitonjam Kanheiya Singh (26) of Khongjom Bazar, Thoubal (KYKL) and
 - iv) Kangjam Naresh Meitei (20) of Awang Lekai, Bishnupur (PREPAK).
 2. On 03.06.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of PREPAK from Sawombung Khunjao near Primary Health Centre under Lamlai-PS, Imphal East district namely, Thangjam Nganba Meetei alias Inao alias Leishabi (23) of Khurai Konsam Leikai under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district. From his possession, 01 (one) four-wheeler and other incriminating items were seized.
- IV. On 02.06.2026, Manipur Police arrested one individual while conducting frisking and checking from Lilong Dam near Nungei area under Lilong-PS, Thoubal district, one MM Warish (33) of Lilong Nungei, Thoubal district. From his possession, 18 (eighteen) nos. of strips suspected to be SP (Serratiopeptidase) capsules weighing 115 grams and 01 (one) two wheeler were seized.
- V. A one-day Mental Health Camp was conducted at 9 IR (Mahila) Battalion Headquarters by a medical team from CMO, Imphal East. A total of 46 women personnel received counselling, of whom 23 were prescribed medication by the psychiatrist. Personnel requiring further support were advised follow-up counselling and treatment. The Battalion Medical Officer and the visiting psychiatrist will conduct another round of counselling and treatment next month.

- VI. Movement of **736** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches in order to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VII. A total of **114** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VIII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
