

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 12th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 12.07.2026, security forces arrested one Chagisongtanbou Nkhamnamai (46) of Makui Naga Village from Yairipok Pechi Road near Angom Football Turf area under Yairipok-PS, Thoubal district along with the following:
 - i. 01 (one) SLR with magazine,
 - ii. 10 (ten) 7.62mm live rounds, and
 - iii. 01 (one) Bolero car.
 2. On 11.07.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist active cadre of KCP (Nongdrenkhomba), one Md. Motim alias Lanthoiba alias Nanao (31) of Kiyamgei Muslim Awang Leikai from Khurai Nandeibam Leikai under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
 3. On 11.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (Nongdrenkhomba), one Thongam Preethyngamba Meitei (26) of Singjamei Makha Khongnang Pheidekpi, Imphal West district from Wangkhei Ayangpalli Road under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
 4. On 11.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of UPPK, one Salam Bijanda Singh alias Deepak alias Major (37) of Arong Nongmaikhong Mayai Leikai, Kakching district, a/p Kakwa Liwa Lambi, Maibam Leikai, Imphal West district from the proximity of Karkinos Hospital, Porompat Ayangpalli Road under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
- IV. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
 1. From 06.07.2026 to 12.07.2026, Manipur Police issued **257 (two hundred fifty seven)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 2,76,000/- (two lakh seventy six thousand)**.
 2. From 06.07.2026 to 12.07.2026, tinted films from **90 (ninety)** vehicles were removed and a vehicle was seized.
- V. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
