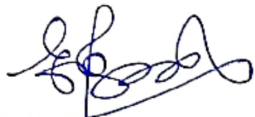


PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 13th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 12.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of PREPAK, one Ningombam Amuthoi Meitei (30) of Chingnungkok Maning Leikai, Imphal East district from Yourabung Panthoibi Leikai under Lamalai-PS, Imphal East district along with eight hand grenades.
 2. On 12.07.2026, Manipur Police recovered 49 (Forty-Nine) packets of suspected opium weighing approximately 49.500 kgs, from a Hyundai Creta (NL-07CE-0841) which was found abandoned near Hengbung Baptist Church along NH-2 after it sped away from T. Khullen naka check point under Senapati-PS, Senapati district.

Documents belonging to one Z. Reithingam (52) of Kamphasom Ukhrul were also recovered from the vehicle. Further investigation follows.
- IV. Movement of **300** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- V. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
