

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 16th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 16.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (PWG), one Tourangbam David Singh alias Sanamba (24) of Wangjing Bazar Lamding Laishram Leikai under Thoubal-PS, Thoubal district from his residence.
- IV. On 15.07.2026, Manipur Police recovered from Sora Awang Leikai area under Kakching-PS, Kakching district a Honda Dio two-wheeler which was reported stolen earlier from Andro Parking, Imphal East.
Further investigation follows.
- V. Manipur Police in collaboration with the Imphal zonal unit of NCB held a one day training program on 'PIT ND&PS & Financial Investigation on ND&PS Cases' on 15.07.2026 at SP Senapati Conference Hall for investigating officers of Senapati district. Investigating Officers of the district engaged in ND&PS cases were sensitised on various aspects of investigation by resource persons and experts of the NCB.
- VI. A total of **113** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley, and **02** persons were detained.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
