

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 20th July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 20.07.2026, two bunkers were destroyed during a joint operation by security forces in the village of Thawai Kuki, and surrounding area of Ukhrul district. The following were also recovered:
 - i) 02 (Two) single barrel rifles,
 - ii) 10 (Ten) live rounds ammunition of different calibers,
 - iii) 01 (One) ammunition waist belt/pouch, and
 - iv) 01 (One) pistol with magazine.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 19.07.2026, security forces arrested 03 (three) active cadres of KYKL from the vicinity of Indo-Myanmar Border Pillar No. 50 under Chakpikarong-PS, Chandel district:
 - i. S/S Lance Corporal Heikrujam Builder (36) of Khongjom Tengol Leikai, Thoubal district,
 - ii. S/S Lance Corporal Lanchenba Sarma alias Puremba alias Kongam (24) of Keibi Khullen Mayai Leikai, Imphal East, and
 - iii. S/S Lance Corporal Khoirampam Raison alias Rangu alias Chaoba alias Jenith (34) of Awang Sekmai Mayai Leikai, Imphal West.
- IV. A total of **112** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley and 1 person was detained.
- V. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
