

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 21st July 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. A Homecoming Ceremony for 42 cadres of KCP (PWG) was held on 21 July 2026 at HQ IGAR (South), Mantripukhri, Imphal, where they laid down arms before the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Manipur, Shri Yumnam Khemchand Singh. A total of 28 weapons, including AK series rifles, RPGs, pistols and other war-like stores comprising grenades, IEDs, detonators, ammunition and wireless sets were surrendered. The cadres will be rehabilitated under the Government of India's Revised Scheme for Surrender-cum-Rehabilitation of Militants in the North East States, 2018. Combined efforts of Security Forces including Manipur Police, CRPF, BSF, ITBP, AR and Army are further continuing in this regard.
- III. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
- IV. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 - i. On 20.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of UNLF (P) from Kairang Paomei Colony area under Heingang-PS, Imphal East district, one Tayenjam Nerish Singh alias Pibarel (26) of Singjamei Thongam Leikai, Imphal West district. From his possession, one four-wheeler Toyota Urban Cruiser was seized.
 - ii. On 21.07.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre of PREPAK (PRO) one, S/S captain Lourembam Kumar Meitei alias Kanto alias Naobi alias Abung (43) of Haobam Marak Lourem Leikai, Imphal West district from Lilong Alia Lamkhai area under Lilong-PS, Thoubal district. From him, one .32 pistol along with magazine was recovered.
- V. A joint team of Manipur Police and Delhi Police recovered four luxury cars including three Toyota Fortuners and a Kia Seltos during an extensive search operation on 19.07.2026 and 20.07.2026 in general area of Ukhrul town to track stolen vehicles related to a FIR case.
- VI. On 19.07.2026, Manipur Police recovered 28 soap cases containing suspected brown sugar weighing approximately 328 grams from an abandoned bag during routine patrolling between Parbung and Lungthulien villages under Parbung-PS, Pherzawl district. The suspected carrier fled into the adjoining forest on noticing the police and escaped taking advantage of darkness. Further investigation follows.
- VII. Movement of **172** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.



VIII. A total of **116** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.

IX. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
