

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 28th July, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 28.07.2026, security forces recovered from the foothills of Seijang Cheirao Ching area, Imphal East district, the following:
 - i. 01 (one) .303 rifle with magazine,
 - ii. 03 (three) 12-bore single barrel guns,
 - iii. 01 (one) .22 rifle,
 - iv. 01 (one) anti-riot gun,
 - v. 03 (three) mortar shells,
 - vi. 02 (two) No. 36 hand grenades,
 - vii. 43 (forty three) live rounds ammunition of different calibers,
 - viii. 03 (three) tear smoke grenades,
 - ix. 05 (five) wireless sets, and
 - x. 01 (one) AK rifle magazine.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 27.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an active cadre of RPF/PLA, one Yendrembam Athouba Meitei alias Atomba alias Takhelngamba (21) of Moreh Premnagar Ward No. 4, Tengnoupal district from an abandoned house located at New Lambulane under Porompat-PS.
 2. On 27.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested from Nungoo Lamkhai under Sugnu-PS, Kakching district 02 (two) active cadres of SOREPA, both residents of Khongyam Makha Leikai:
 - i) Marcus Thiyam alias Tompok (22) and
 - ii) Heikrujam William Meitei (22).
- IV. On 27.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested 02 (two) residents of Sora Mamang Leikai, Kakching district from a mobile check point along Chandel Road under Kakching-PS, Kakching district:
 - i). Md. Izaz (19) and
 - ii). Md. Mujibur Rahaman (23).A Honda Activa 125 Disc, Rebel Red Metallic colour, without registration number which was reported stolen earlier from MG Avenue, Imphal was recovered from the duo.
- V. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.

VI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
