

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 29th July, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 28.07.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist active cadre s/s Sergeant Major of UNLF (P), one Samadram Jagat Singh alias Thambaljao alias Romen (49) of Thoubal Haokha a/p Tokpa Ching Mayai Leikai, Kakching district from his current locality under Arong-PS.
 2. On 29.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested one Moirangthem Sanjoy alias Aya (33) of Khagempalli Pankha Nganapi Thong Mamang, Imphal West district from North AOC area under Imphal-PS. The arrestee was involved in firing of arms at a public place in North AOC earlier.
A .45 NPB Pistol with magazine along with five live rounds were recovered from him.
 3. On 29.07.2026, security forces arrested an extortionist active member of PUYA (People's United Youth Alliance), an unregistered youth organisation from his residence, one Oinam Nikarson Singh (27) of Leimapokpam Mayai Leikai under Nambol-PS, Bishnupur district.
Three receipt booklets and documents containing the details of employees of Health Department were seized from him.
 4. On 29.07.2026, security forces arrested an active woman cadre of KCP (Nongdrenkhomba), one Luwangthem Ronita Devi alias Toro (24) of Keirao Wangkhem Maning Leikai from Khurai Heikhrumakhong area under Porompat-PS, Imphal East district.
- IV. On 29.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested an accused person involved in a FIR case under ND&PS Act registered at Senapati-PS, one Aditya Dhakal (25) of Panikheti Irang Part-II under Kangpokpi-PS, Kangpokpi district from Charhazare, near Motbung, Kangpokpi district.
- V. On 29.07.2026, Manipur Police arrested from Shanta Bazar under Andro-PS, Imphal East district two women who were involved in the illegal procurement, transportation and sale of arms and explosives:
 - 1) Ruhida Begum (46) and
 - 2) Rohana Begum (18)

A hand grenade the duo had brought to Shanta Bazar to sell to a prospective buyer was seized from them.
- VI. On 28.07.2026, security forces arrested one Mr. Partha Duik Borah (27) of Baligaon, Assam along with 06 (six) soap cases of suspected Heroin Powder weighing 92 grams from Phougakchao Ikhai Bazar under Phougakchao Ikhai-PS, Bishnupur district.

- VII. An accused person in a ND&PS case registered at Maram-PS, one Ms. K. Lucy (44) of Mao Karong village surrendered at the temporary prison, Senapati today following cancellation of her bail by the court.
- VIII. On 29.07.2026, **4th India Reserve Battalion** conducted a cleanliness drive at Sardar Patel High School, Khurkhul along with the school authorities as part of the Battalion's Community Policing Initiative. As part of the outreach, a RO water purifier was also donated to the school to ensure students have access to clean drinking water for their midday meals. Manipur Police remains committed to building stronger ties with the community and supporting the well-being of our students.
- IX. Movement of **150** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- X. A total of **112** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- XI. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
