11. First Information contents:

Brief of the case:

Today i.e., 25/04/2026 at 05:00 p.m., received reliable information that a convoy of 18 Assam Rifles on official duty, which came from Ukhrul towards Hoomi village via Talui village on NH-102(A), deliberately dashed against the road barricade/barrier pole put across the road at Talui village by the women folk for checking movement of suspicious vehicles in relation to the ongoing communal clash between Kukis and the Tangkhuls. During such negligent and reckless driving on the part of the driver of the Tata truck (Registration No. not verified at the time of receipt of the information), one of the women, namely Rose Vashum (47 Yrs) W/o (Late) Lazarus Vashum of Talui village, suffered grievous injuries on her head. The vehicles sped away towards Hoomi village without stopping. She was immediately evacuated to District Hospital for treatment and later referred to Imphal for intensive treatment. Thereafter, when the same troop of Assam Rifles reached Hoomi village, another group of villagers put a barricade on the road and tried to stop them. But, the Assam Rifles resorted to firing live rounds so as to deter and disperse the mob. During the firing, one individual by the name Mashunphong Zingkhai (32 Yrs) S/o Ngahami Zingkhai of Hoomi village suffered a bullet injury on the side of his head close to the neck. He was also evacuated to District Hospital, Ukhrul and is being treated there.

From our own source, it was also learnt that prior to the occurrence of the incidents mentioned above, some of the personnel of 18 Assam Rifles who were returning to their native homes on official leave in a private vehicle on the same day i.e., on 25/04/2026, were intercepted at Hoomi village by the villagers on village protection duty and held captive in their custody without letting them proceed further. On receipt of the information, personnel of 18 Assam Rifles became apprehensive for the safety of their personnel and rushed towards Hoomi village to rescue them. On their way to Hoomi village, they came across the women folk blocking the road by putting a pole barrier across the road at Talui village. Without hesitating, the AR personnel dashed against the unauthorized pole barrier made by a long bamboo. In the said incident, Rose Vashum (whose particulars are given above) suffered injuries. When the Assam Rifles reached Hoomi village, they were stopped by another mob again. During the altercation, the Assam Rifles fired a few rounds and injured Mashunphong Zingkhai (whose particulars are given above).

Based on the above series of incidents, a Sou-Motu case under F.I.R No. 2(4)2026 SDL/PS w/s 281/125/117(2)/106(2)/109/126(2)/127(2)/221/189(2)/191(2)/285 BNS is registered for investigation.
