Sir,

I have the honour to report that today, i.e. 14/08/2026 as a preventive precautionary measure taken up by CDO Unit, Kakching in connection with upcoming Independence Day, at about 04:00 a.m., reliable information was received regarding the movement of armed miscreants and the suspected concealment of arms and ammunition by various armed groups which was looted from various armouries at Double Khong Marifangbi canal area under Arong Police Station.

Immediately, a combined team of CDO Unit, Kakching, comprising K-36, K-49 and K-74, along with a team of Arong Police Station, led by Sub.Yengkhom Shaktishen Singh, OC/CDO Unit, Kakching, and one column of 46 Assam Rifles, led by Maj. Yashvardhan, under the command of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), Kakching, and under the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching District, proceeded to the suspected location.

During the search operation, the area was properly cordoned off and a thorough search of the suspected locations was conducted with the assistance of a metal detector. During the search, at Double Khong Marifangbi canal area, some items suspected to have been concealed under water by unknown miscreants were found wrapped in rubber tubes. Upon opening the rubber tubes one by one, the following items were recovered:

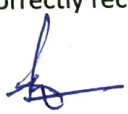

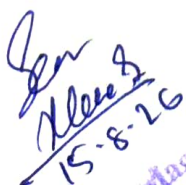

I have the honour to report that today, i.e. 14/08/2026 as a part of preventive precautionary measure taken up by CDO Unit, Kakching in connection with upcoming Independence Day, at about 04:00 a.m., received a reliable information regarding the movement of armed miscreants and the suspected concealment of arms and ammunition by various armed groups which was looted from various armouries at Doublo Khong Marifangbi canal area under Arong Police Station.

Immediately, a combined team of CDO Unit, Kakching, comprising Kilo-36, Kilo -49 and Kilo -74, and one Civil team, along with a team of Arong Police Station, led by Sub. Yengkhom Shaktishen Singh, OC/CDO Unit, Kakching, and two columns of 46 Assam Rifles, led by Maj. Yashvardhan and Maj Anupam under the command of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), Kakching, and under the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching District rushed to the said location and conducted cordon and search operations. During the search operations, the area was cordoned off from various directions Kilo-49 along with his Mobile team and one column of 46 Assam Rifles cordoned from Eastern side of Hiyanglam Heranmei towards the said location and Kilo- 36 & Kilo-74 along with Arong PS team and a column of 46 AR cordoned off from Western side towards to the indicated location.

Upon reaching to the suspected area, a thorough search of the suspected locations was conducted by Kilo 36 led by HC Kh Shyamsundar Singh and Civil team led by HC N Bidyananda Singh, along with 46 AR with the assistance of a metal detector. During the search at Doublo Khong Marifangbi canal area, some items suspected to have been concealed under water by unknown miscreants were found wrapped in rubber tubes. Upon opening the rubber tubes one by one, the following items were recovered:
