I have the honour to report that today, i.e. 22/08/2026, at about 3:30 p.m., reliable information was received from our own sources corroborated with 46 AR regarding the presence of an active cadre of the banned organization PREPAK at Kakching Mayai Leikai area, Kakching District.

Acting upon the said information, a combined team of CDO Unit, Kakching, comprising Kilo-30 and Kilo-76, along with lady CDO personnel, led by Subedar Ksh. Prakash Singh, under the command of Subedar Yengkhom Shaktishen Singh, OC/CDO Unit, Kakching, under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), Kakching. Immediately proceeded to the suspected location and conducted a cordon-and-search operation in the area.

During the operation, one suspected individual was detained from the rental house of Yengkhom Ojit Singh, located at Kakching Mayai Leikai, Irum Lai Pareng. On preliminary interrogation, the detainee identified himself as Laishram Ganga Singh @ Tomchou, aged 44 years, S/o (L) L. Amuchou Singh of Sekmaijin Mamang Leikai, Heibongkhong, presently residing at Kakching Mayai Leikai, Irum Lai Pareng.

During sustained interrogation, he disclosed that he was an active cadre of the banned organization PREPAK and had joined the organization in the year 2005 through one S/S Major Sachi of the said organization. He further disclosed that he underwent military training at Keibul Lamjao under Army No. 221 of the 11th batch. He also disclosed that he had earlier been arrested by 21 Assam Rifles in 2012 and by 40 Assam Rifles in 2015. After being released on bail, he re-joined the banned organization PREPAK through one Ningthi in the year 2024. He is also highly suspected in caching of the arms and ammunitions of his organisation.

Based on his disclosure and the available incriminating evidence, he was arrested at the spot at 4:15 p.m. From his possession, one Redmi 5G mobile phone bearing IMEI No. 1: 868428066539424 and IMEI No. 2: 868428066539432, along with two Jio SIM cards bearing Nos. 8787809971 and 8798736247, were recovered and seized at the spot at 4:30 p.m., after observing all necessary legal formalities. The seizure proceedings were also videographed at the spot.

During further interrogation, he disclosed that one Nongmaithem Romesh Singh, aged 43 yrs. S/o N. Modhuchandra Singh of Kakching Mayai Leikai, Kakching District, another active cadre of the banned organization was involved in caching of arms and ammunitions of the banned organisation.

Acting upon the said disclosure, the team proceeded to the residence of Nongmaithem Romesh Singh at Kakching Mayai Leikai and detained him. On questioning, he identified himself as Nongmaithem Romesh Singh, aged 43 years, S/o N. Modhuchandra Singh of Kakching Mayai Leikai, Kakching District. During sustained interrogation, he disclosed that he was an active cadre of the banned organization PLA and had initially joined the organization in the year 2006 as an over-ground worker. He further disclosed that he had earlier been arrested by a combined team of CDO and IRB personnel in 2006. After being released on bail, he re-joined the banned organization PREPAK through one S/S Commander Ningthi, and presently working under his command. During further interrogation, he disclosed that he had concealed arms and ammunition inside his bedroom which was given by Ningthi in the year 2024. Accordingly, the team was taken to the location pointed out by him. On searching the indicated area, the team found two separate bundles wrapped in white transparent plastic and black tape. Upon opening the packets, the following items were recovered:

1. One (1) 6-round revolver, bearing Body No. 463513.
2. Six (6) live rounds of .38 ammunition.
3. One (1) white transparent plastic sheet/wrapper.
4. Torn papers.

Hence he was arrested at the spot at 6:45 p.m by observing all legal formalities.



In addition, one Redmi 5G mobile phone bearing IMEI No. 1: 868074075589628 and IMEI No. 2: 868074075589636, along with one Jio SIM card bearing No. 7005090698, was recovered from his possession. The above-mentioned articles were recovered and seized at 7:10 p.m., after observing all necessary legal formalities. The entire seizure proceedings were also videographed at the spot.

Thereafter, the arrested individuals, along with the seized articles, arrest intimation and grounds of arrest, are hereby handed over to you for taking up further necessary legal action as per law.
