The brief fact of the case is that on 28/06/2026 at 7:45 pm received a written complaint report from Mr. Jangkhohim Khongsai, General Secretary, Committee on Tribal Unity (CoTU) stating that, Office Bearers and responsible leaders of the Naga People's Organisation (NPO), Tahamzam, Senapati, Office Bearers, responsible leaders of the NHACM including Mr. Kokhopao Liangmai, Chairman Thonglang Village Authority (Naga Humanitarian Aids Committee), Namdilog, Kanglatongbi Bazar Board and Naga People's Organisation (NPO) alleged and directed or authorized the blocking of food grains and other humanitarian relief materials intended for Kuki-Zo civilians in the IT Road area. According to information received by CoTU, residents of Thonglang Liangmai Naga Village stated that the blockade was carried out under the supervision of the NPO. It is further alleged that members and leaders associated with the NHACM/Kanglatongbi Bazar Board facilitated or supported the obstruction of food grains and other essential commodities meant for Kuki-Zo civilians within Kangpokpi District. The deliberate obstruction of humanitarian assistance and essential food supplies to civilians, if established, is contrary to humanitarian principles and may constitute offences under applicable provisions of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other relevant laws.

Hence, a case under FIR No. 17(6)2026 KPI-PS U/S 126(2)/221/351(3)/324(2)/189(1)/61(2) BNS has been registered for investigation.

Subject: **First Information Report (FIR) regarding alleged obstruction of humanitarian relief supplies intended for Kuki-Zo civilians.**

Sir,

On behalf of the Committee on Tribal Unity (CoTU), we hereby lodge this First Information Report seeking immediate registration of a criminal case and investigation into the alleged obstruction of humanitarian relief materials meant for Kuki-Zo civilians residing in the IT Road area of Kangpokpi District today the 28th June, 2026 at around 02:00 PM at Thonglang Village IT Road.

Accused Persons/Organizations:

- (a) Office Bearers and responsible leaders of the Naga People's Organisation (NPO), Tahamzam, Senapati including Mr Kokhopao Liangmai, Chairman Thonglang Village Authority.
- (b) Office Bearers and responsible leaders of the NHACM (Naga Humanitarian Aids Committee), Namdilong, Kanglatongbi Bazar Board. (Economic Blockade undergoing presently at Imphal Dimapur Road NH 2).

Allegations:

It has been alleged that leaders of the Naga People's Organisation (NPO) directed and authorized the blocking of foodgrains and other humanitarian relief materials intended for Kuki-Zo civilians in the IT Road area. According to information received by CoTU, residents of Thonglang Liangmai Naga Village stated that the blockade was carried out under the supervision and instructions of the NPO.

It is further alleged that members and leaders associated with the NHACM/Kanglatongbi Bazar Board facilitated or supported the obstruction of foodgrains and other essential commodities meant for Kuki-Zo civilians within Kangpokpi District.

The deliberate obstruction of humanitarian assistance and essential food supplies to civilians, if established, is contrary to humanitarian principles and may constitute offences under applicable provisions of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and other relevant laws.

1. Groups of mobs/villagers of Thonglang Village under the directions & Authorisation of NPO (Naga Peoples Organisation leaders) unlawfully prevented relief vehicles and personnel from proceeding to its destination.
2. Obstruction of Security escorts from proceeding carrying relief items.
3. Threats are used to stop Relief convoy from proceeding by planting roadblocks.
4. Four (4) vehicles Tyres carrying Relief materials are damaged to prevent from proceeding.
5. The obstruction is planned and authorised by NPO at Thonglang Village.
6. The NHAM (Naga Humanitarian Aids Committee) block Humanitarian Aid by imposing Economic Blockade at NH 2 for the Kuki-Zo inhabitants of Kangpokpi District.

Ensure immediate restoration and protection of unhindered humanitarian access and the movement of essential commodities for all affected civilians.

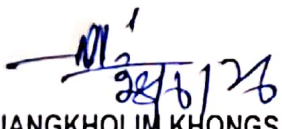
CoTU assures its full cooperation with the investigation and is prepared to provide available information and witnesses to assist the police.
