Subject: Complaint regarding Obstruction of Security Forces and Damage to Government Equipment at Waphong Village

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1. I, JC-193096 Rank: Nb Sub (GD) Name: B B Pradhan of 19 Assam Rifles, presently deployed with the Commandant's QRT, respectfully submit this complaint requesting registration of an FIR regarding an incident that occurred at Waphong Village on 11 March 2026 during a search operation conducted by security forces.
2. On 11 March 2026 at approximately 0810 hours, Commandant 19 Assam Rifles along with the Quick Reaction Team, including myself, reached Waphong Village while carrying out follow-up search operations in the area. During the operation, one bunker suspected to be used by miscreants was identified and subsequently destroyed by the security forces.
3. Soon after the destruction of the bunker, a large crowd of approximately 150—200 womenfolk along with 45—50 village volunteers assembled at the location and began agitating against the security forces. The crowd surrounded the troops and obstructed them while they were performing their official duties.
4. During the course of the agitation and commotion, some members of the crowd attempted to forcibly snatch an AK 47 Magazine from the soldiers. The troops immediately intervened and the magazine was recovered without loss. However, during the disturbance caused by the agitating crowd, the following government equipments were damaged:-
- 4.1. Magazine of 5.56 mm INSAS LMG — 01 No (Damaged)
 - 4.2. Ballistic Goggles (eye protection) — 01 No (Broken)
5. After the incident, the following individuals were identified as probable perpetrators and instigators who played an active role in inciting and leading the mob:-
- 5.1 Guijuanang Inka, resident of Kabui Khullen village.
 - 5.2 Akhamba, resident of Pungmon Chingchen village.
 - 5.3 Guangji Khumba, resident of Inthan (Waphong) village.
 - 5.4 Mr Saloni Toni, President of Senapati Dist Students Association.
 - 5.5 Mr Lanhungba, slo B T Kinguilung of Pungmon village.
6. The above acts constitute serious offences punishable under relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, including but not limited to:-
- 6.1 Section 190 — Unlawful Assembly
 - 6.2 Section 191 — Rioting
 - 6.3 Section 221 — Obstructing a Public Servant in Discharge of Public Functions
 - 6.4 Section 324 — Mischief causing damage to property
 - 6.5 Section 351 — Criminal Intimidation
7. In view of the above facts, it is respectfully requested that:-
- 7.1 An FIR may kindly be registered at the earliest.
 - 7.2 A thorough investigation into the incident may be conducted.
 - 7.3 Legal action may be taken against the aforementioned individuals and other unknown persons involved.
8. I am ready to cooperate fully and provide any further information required during the course of investigation.
