13. First Information contents:

One Gyan Bahadur Tamang (55) Yrs. Chairman. Nine Miles Poudel Basti village, S/o Laxman Tamang lodged a written report with OC/KPI-PS stating that on 26/06/2026, at around 4:30 pm, the armed miscreants came to his house while he was present at his paddy field near his house. However they did not notice or see him and remained hidden to protect his life and safety. He witnessed the incident from his paddy field. However, had they seen him, they might have attacked or harmed him. Eight (8) men came to his house asking for him. Out of the eight, six (6) not apparently familiar were armed with sophisticated automatic rifles and dressed in camouflage outfits. However, two (2) were familiar. One of them was Mr. Victor Wijunamai, a Government teacher of Benamai Junior High School. He is the son of W. Renchong of Thonglang Atongba Village. The other is Mr. Waipou, S/o Marilongbou, also a resident of the same village. The said miscreants were demanding a sum of ₹ 5000 from each household of his village failing which they have given an ultimatum to vacate and leave the village for good. This is an indirect implication to leave the village. Recently the Chairman of Thonglang Atongba Village and Chairman of Chawangking Village threatening him and his villager to pay 1000 per house to them. Thonglang Atongba Chairman took 60,000, (Sixty thousand) and Chawangking village Chairman took 60,000 (Sixty thousand) forcefully, they have done same behavior to other Nepali Gorkhas villager in their area. From 2016 to till date Thonglang Atongba village Authority and their youth raided his house 5 times to kidnaped him, because of this repeated threats they are living under constant fear. On the intervening night of 24/02/2026, a group of armed miscreants carrying sophisticated weapons and dressed in combat uniforms raided the house of Ex-Secretary. They forcefully broke open the door of the residence and searched all the rooms. Thereafter, the miscreants demanded to know the location of the Village Chairman and Secretary's houses. They further forced the house owner to take them to the Secretary's residence. However, both the Secretary and the Chairman were out of station that day. After confirming this, the miscreants left the village. Their actions were highly threatening, unlawful and disturbing. Due to these continuous threats, he, as the Chairman of 9 Miles Poudel Basti Village, along with Secretary and the entire village community, feel unsafe and mentally stressed. Further, in January 2024, similar miscreants again raided their village. The then Secretary of the village, Mr. Raju Gewali, was abducted and severely beaten. After this incident, Mr. Raju Gewali left the village for his safety. In the name of ancestral land, these miscreants have been continuously harassing village social workers, leaders, and residents by illegally collecting land tax. The land ownership case is currently pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Manipur and the District Court, Kangpokpi. Moreover, an undertaking was signed on 9th September 2021 between the Village Authority of Thonglang Atongba and the Gorkha leaders of Irang Part-I Village in the office of the Superintendent of Police, Kangpokpi, stating that the Village Authority of Thonglang Atongba would not disturb the residents of 9 Miles Poudel Basti Village, Irang Part-I. Both parties agreed to abide by the court's decision. Despite this agreement, illegal tax collection and intimidation are still continuing. Due to threats and obstruction of movement of commuter along the IT Road by the Nagas, there is delay in movement. So, could not report in time.

Hence, a case under FIR No. 19(7)2026 KPI-PS u/s 61(2)/ 308(2) /329(4)/ 351(3) /196(1)/ 3(5) BNS & 25(1-C) Arms Act has been registered for investigation.

Sub:- Complaint regarding frequent threats by Armed Miscreants and request for protection.

Respected Sir,

Under grief circumstances, I am addressing this letter to you.

On the 26/06/2026, at around 4:30 pm, the armed miscreants came to my house, I was present at my paddy field near my house. However they did not notice or see me, I remained hidden to protect my life and safety. I witnessed the incident from my paddy field. However, had they seen me, they might have attacked or harmed me. Eight (8) men came to my house asking for me. Out of the eight, six (6) not apparently familiar were armed with sophisticated automatic rifles and dressed in camouflage outfits. However, two (2) were familiar. One of them was Mr. Victor Wijunamai, a Government teacher of Benamai Junior High School. He is the son of W. Renchong of Thonglang Atongba Village. The other is Mr. Waipou, S/o Marilongbou, also a resident of the same village.

The said miscreants were demanding a sum of ₹ 5000 from each household of my village failing which they have given an ultimatum to vacate and leave the village for good. This is an indirect implication to leave the village.

On the intervening night of 24/02/2026, a group of armed miscreants carrying sophisticated weapons and dressed in combat uniforms raided the house of my Ex-Secretary. They forcefully broke open the door of the residence and searched all the rooms. Thereafter, the miscreants demanded to know the location of the Village Chairman and Secretary's houses. Sir, due to these continuous threats, I, as the Chairman of 9 Miles Poudel Basti Village, along with my Secretary and the entire village community, feel unsafe and mentally stressed. We are deeply concerned about our personal safety and that of our families. Such activities may lead to serious consequences if immediate action is not taken.

Further, in January 2024, similar miscreants again raided our village. The then Secretary of our village, Mr. Raju Gewali, was abducted and severely beaten. After this incident, Mr. Raju Gewali left the village for his safety.

Sir, in the name of ancestral land, these miscreants have been continuously harassing village social workers, leaders, and residents by illegally collecting land tax. The land ownership case is currently pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Manipur and the District Court, Kangpokpi.

Moreover, an undertaking was signed on 9th September 2021 between the Village Authority of Thonglang Atongba and the Gorkha leaders of Irang Part-I Village in the office of the Superintendent of Police, Kangpokpi, stating that the Village Authority of Thonglang Atongba would not disturb the residents of 9 Miles Poudel Basti Village, Irang Part-I. Both parties agreed to abide by the court's decision. Despite this agreement, illegal tax collection and intimidation are still continuing.

Due to threats and obstruction of movement of commuter along the IT Road by the Nagas, there is delay in movement. So, I could not report in time.

So, in view of the subject stated above, I am requesting you to:

- I) Immediate investigation and arrest of the above identified miscreants and take necessary legal actions.
- II) Arrange a Police Outpost in Nine Miles Poudel Basti Village (PO & PS Kangpokpi)
- III) Immediate stoppage of illegal taxation and disturbance of residents of the village.

I, therefore, urgently request you to help me and my villagers live a peaceful life.

NB: The same man i.e., Mr. Victor Wijunamai was the main culprit behind the burning down of my house in the year 2016 (Ref. FIR No. 45(11)2016 KPI-PS u/s 436/427 IPC).and also collecting illegal tax from my village and I have a Video footage.
