13. First Information contents:

The brief fact of the case is that today, i.e., 11.07.2026 at about 5:30 PM, received a reliable information that, on the same day at about 03:00 PM, unknown miscreants believed to be Liangmai Naga volunteers associated with NSCM-IM, armed with sophisticated firearms, allegedly attacked and opened fire upon a couple of Kuki farmer while working in their Ginger Farm at a place situated approximately 59 kilometres South-West of Kangpokpi Police Station. As a result of the attack, Mr. Haolal Singsit (53) yrs s/o Paokhohen Singsit of Govajang village, I.T. Road, PO-T. Waichong, PS-Kangpokpi, T Waichong Sub-Division, Kangpokpi District, Manipur was shot dead at the spot while his wife Nemneikim made a narrow escape.

According to the deceased wife, on hearing the gun shot, both fled from the spot and she was running ahead of her husband. After covering certain distance and look back, her husband Haolal Singsit was not seen anywhere. Nemneikim rushed to her village and reported the matter to the villagers that her husband was missing. The villagers formed a search party and later found the lifeless body of Haolal Singsit.

The incident discloses the commission of cognizable offences involving murder by use of firearms and unlawful activities by armed militants.

Hence, a Suo-Motu case under FIR No. 21(7)2026 KPI-PS u/s 109/101/103(1)/116/3(5) BNS & 25 (1-C) A. Act has been registered for investigation into the matter.

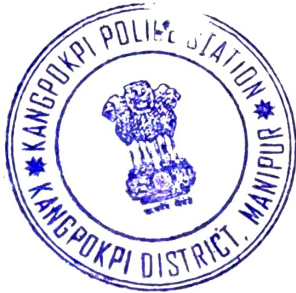
