REQUISITION FOR FIRST INFORMATION REPORT

Input

1. Based on specific input received from local source regarding the movement of RC Singson, Army Chief of United Kuki National Army (UKNA) HMAR, who was involved in training, raising and extortion activities. Specific int was received that the individual was carrying extortion activities in general area Thingchawm, Churachandpur at around 2100 hours on 04 Aug 2026.

Background

2. RC Singson is a Key functionary of UKNA HMAR and has been involved in anti national activities including cadre training, raising of armed groups and extortion in Churachandpur district and adjoining areas.

Operation Launch

3. An operation was launched on 04 Aug 2026 at 2300 hours (16 Km South East of Headquarter Veng). At around 2330 hours his location was given to be in densely forested area behind village Thingchawm. The party searched the location for more than two hours but could not locate him due to difficult terrain friction and dense forested area. The columns under Lt Col Nitin Sharma and Maj Kumar Saurav laid an ambush on likely exit routes. However, the individual could not be apprehended. The columns returned to Headquarter at 0400 hours on 04 Aug 2026.

Course of Action

4. Due to continuous monitoring and coordination with 11 WEU & local sources, information was received at around 1300 hours on 05 Aug 2026 that the location of R C Singson was at village Old Gelmoul village (6 Km North West to Headquarter Veng), Churachandpur. One column under command Lt Col Nitin Sharma and one column under command Maj Kumar Saurav of 05 Assam Rifles moved to general area Old Gelmoul, village, Churachandpur (6 Km North West to Headquarter Veng) from different routes to block his escape. At around 1330 hours the party reached the location and cordoned off the suspected house while maintaining continuous close surveillance. At 1600 hours the search party was launched in the suspected house. Upon seeing the presence of Assam Rifles columns, the individual tried to flee from the location into the jungle. However, due to swift and well-orchestrated action by the columns, the individual was apprehended after a brief physical scuffle and was brought to Headquarter Veng at 1645 hours for further questioning.

During the questioning, the individual provided information about hidden arms cache in general area Thingchawm vill in the forested area. On the basis of this input, an operation was launched at 2000 hours to search for the cache. After a thorough search of the area as indicated by the cadre, cache of arms and ammunition was recovered at 2345 hours in Jungle of Thingchawm village, Churachandpur.

8. Apprehended cadre alongwith recovered items are being handed over to Churachandpur Police Station on 06th August 2026 at 0910 hours. You are requested to file a complaint against individual under relevant act and carryout further necessary investigation.

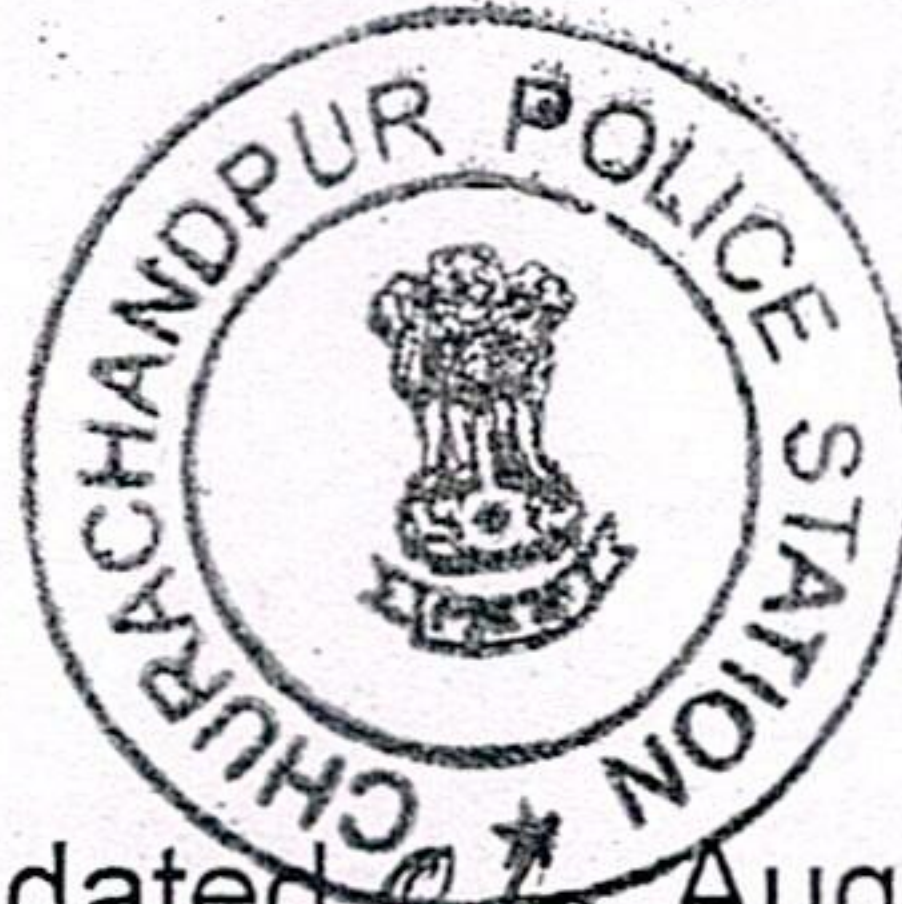
