FIRST INFORMATION REPORT

- Based on intelligence gathered from own sources regarding the presence of two (02) United Kuki National Army (UKNA) cadres in Churachandpur town carrying out extortion and being involved in drug and wpn trafficking, an Op was launched on 11 Aug 26 at 1900 Hr and two UKNA cadres (Non SoO) were apprehended. The cadres were under continuous surveillance from last ten (10) days. Two Ops were launched before, but the cadres managed to evade own tps and could not be apprehended.
- At 1800 Hr on 11 Aug 26, confirmed information was received that UKNA cadres planned to move from Khengjang Vill, CCPur to Molnom Vill, CCPur and back on a black Royal Enfield Hunter motorcycle with NO registration NO number plate.
- Accordingly, a column of strength 01-01-20 of 37 Assam Rifles move to the general area of Khengjang and deployed tactically. As per the input, the cadres were scheduled to meet an unknown individual for a weapons deal. Therefore, a second column was also tactically and discreetly positioned to neutralize/ apprehend the cadres alongwith the prospective buyer.
- At approx 1930 Hr, both cadres arrived at Molnom Vill on a Royal Enfield motorcycle and proceeded towards Peace Ground to look for the buyer. The columns maintained continuous surveillance on the cadres and waited for them to return to Khengjang Vill.
- While returning towards Khengjang Vill, the cadres noticed they were being followed by a SFs vehicle. They attempted to flee by increasing speed of the motorcycle. After a short chase, they were intercepted by our column positioned at Khengjang Vill and overpowered with all possible exit routes covered. On apprehension, both cadres were brought to Battalion Headquarter, Khuga.

6. On being questioned, the cadres informed about hiding arms and ammunition underground at a location in the outskirts of Bagla Village, CCPur in a densely forested area. On the basis of this input, again an op was launched at 2100 Hr on 11 Aug 26 to search for this cache. After a thorough search of the area as indicated by the cadres, a cache of arms and amn was also recovered at 0345 Hr on 12 Aug 26.

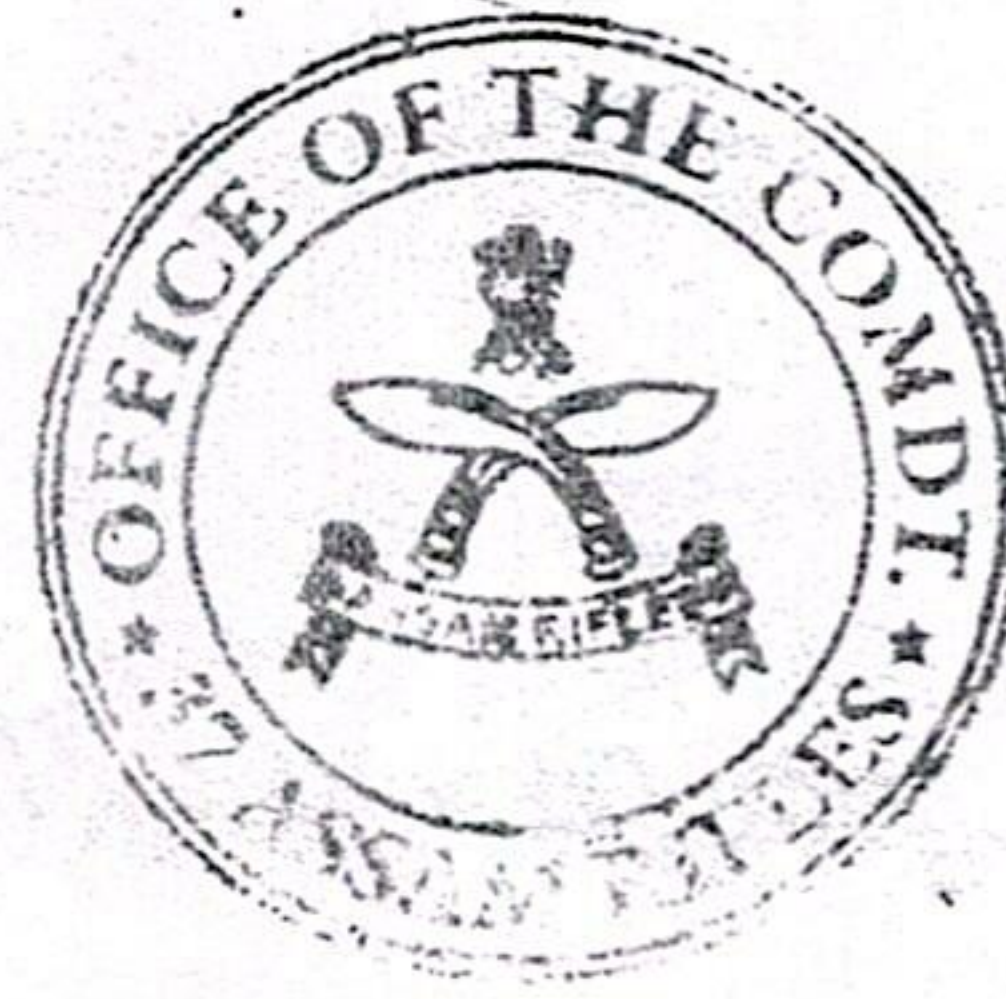
