The brief fact of the case is that Mr. Meshach Letginlal Ngailut (29) yrs. s/o Nehkhohlen Ngailut Chief of S. Changoubung Village lodged a written report to OC/KPI-PS stating that certain volunteers from T. Khullen village unlawfully entered the jurisdiction of S. Changoubung without any permission or authority at around 6:00 am of 21/04/2026. They proceeded to place obstructions on the roads, thereby blocking the free movement of villagers in and out of the area.

Furthermore, the individuals entered the village and attempted to forcibly compel local shopkeepers to shut down their businesses. Their actions caused fear, disruption of normal life, and posed a threat to the peace and security of the village. When S. Changoubung villagers attempted to question and put an end to their actions, it resulted in heated arguments and physical fights from both sides. The situation escalated at around 9:00 am when stone pelting was initiated T. Khullen volunteers, which resulted in 6 (Six) villagers of S. Changoubung sustaining injuries on their bodies and are currently receiving treatment at Kangpokpi District Hospital. Moreover, around 11.30 am, gun shots were fired from T. Khullen village towards S. Changoubung village, resulting in a bullet injury to one young girl.

Hence, a case has been registered under FIR No. 8(4)2026 KPI-PS u/s 329(3)/126(2)/ 351(2)(3) BNS & 25 (1-C) A. Act for investigation.

Subject: Complaint regarding unlawful entry, obstruction, and intimidation during bandh.

Respected Sir,

I, Meshach Letginlal Ngailut, Chief of S. Changoubung Village, would like to lodge a complaint regarding a serious incident that occurred during the bandh called by the United Naga Council from April 21 to April 23, 2026.

During this period, certain volunteers from T. Khullen village unlawfully entered the jurisdiction of S. Changoubung without any permission or authority at around 6:00 am of 21/04/2026. They proceeded to place obstructions on the roads, thereby blocking the free movement of villagers in and out of the area.

Furthermore, the individuals entered the village and attempted to forcibly compel local shopkeepers to shut down their businesses. Their actions caused fear, disruption of normal life and posed a threat to the peace and security of the village. When S. Changoubung villagers attempted to question and put an end to their actions, it resulted in heated arguments and physical fights from both sides. The situation escalated at around 9:00 am when stone pelting was initiated by T. Khullen volunteers, which resulted in 6 (Six) villagers of S. Changoubung sustaining injuries on their bodies and are currently receiving treatment at Kangpokpi District Hospital. Moreover, around 11.30 am, gun shots were fired from T. Khullen village towards S. Changoubung village, resulting in a bullet injury to one young girl.

It is important to state that we have no objection to the bandh itself nor any ill will toward the people of T. Khullen. However, the forceful intrusion into our village, obstruction of public pathways, and acts of intimidation are unlawful and unacceptable.

In view of the above, we kindly request you to:

1. Register this complaint as an FIR
2. Investigate the matter thoroughly
3. Take necessary legal action against those involved
4. Ensure protection of the residents and prevent recurrence of such incidents

We are prepared to cooperate fully with the investigation and provide further details if required.
