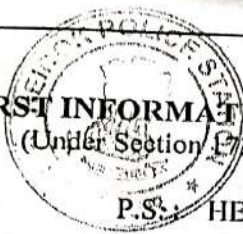

11. First Information contents:

Today i.e. 08/08/2026 at 10:30 am, this police station has received a copy of the Letter No. L-3/2018/SP-TBL/4661 dated 22/07/2026 of Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, Manipur, enclosing the copy of the Letter No. A/2/Addl. SP (L/O)/TBL/2026/133 dated 22/07/2026 which is a report in connection with enquiry/investigation on the circumstances under which the purchase of the land of Heirok Police Station and for identifying all officers and individuals involved with the purchase of the said land. The said Letter of Additional S.P. (LO) Thoubal, also enclosed the connected statements recorded in the enquiry/investigation as well as other documents. On perusal of the records, it is found that the land of Heirok Police Station, which has been under Patta No. 248 (Old), 893 (New), covered by C.S. Dag No. 448, measuring an area of 0.9955 hectares of Revenue Village No. 129 - Heirok, was transferred by Moirangthem Marjit Singh 54 years s/o M. Amuba Singh of Heirok Part II, Thoubal District, Manipur for and in favour of the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, Manipur vide Sale deed dated 23/01/2010. The said Marjit Singh put his signatures on the said sale deed. Further, the said Marjit Singh put his signature on the Memorandum of Consideration Receipt appended in the said sale deed, wherein the said Marjit Singh acknowledged the receipt of a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- as sale price or cost of the land. Again, the said Marjit also put his signature on the Receipt dated

05/02/2010 wherein he acknowledged the receipt of the sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakh) only as sale price or cost of the land from the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District. In consequence of aforesaid transfer of land in favour of the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, the name of Superintendent of Police, Thoubal (Heirok Police Station, Heirok) has been entered in the relevant land records vide the Mutation Case No. 102/SDC/HRK dated 05/04/2010 of the Sub-Deputy Collector, Heirok. In total contradiction to what the said Marjit Singh did as aforesaid, he gave his statement in the enquiry/investigation conducted by the Additional SP (L/O), Thoubal thereby stating that the aforesaid land has no Dag number and Patta number. He further stated that the Government gave no money or amount to him.

It is found that Moirangthem Marjit Singh S/o M. Amuba Singh of Heirok Part-II has given false evidence, false information and committed the offence of cheating after gaining a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakh) only from the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, Manipur and he appears to escape from the case concealing the fact.

Hence, a suo-motu case under FIR No. 23(08)2026 HRK PS U/s 318(4)/314/315/61(2)/217/240/229 BNS, 2023 is taken up against the culprit i.e. Moirangthem Marjit Singh 54 years S/o M. Amuba Singh of Heirok Part-II, Thoubal District, Manipur for investigation.

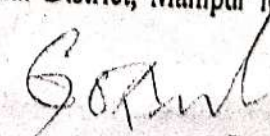

SP (L/O)/TBL/2026/133 dated 22/07/2026 which is a report in connection with enquiry/investigation on the circumstances under which the purchase of the land of Heirok Police Station and for identifying all officers and individuals involved with the purchase of the said land. The said Letter of Additional S.P. (LO) Thoubal, also enclosed the connected statements recorded in the enquiry/investigation as well as other documents. On perusal of the records, it is found that the land of Heirok Police Station, which has been under Patta No. 248 (Old), 893 (New), covered by C.S. Dag No. 448, measuring an area of 0.9955 hectares of Revenue Village No. 129 – Heirok, was transferred by Moirangthem Marjit Singh 54 years s/o M. Amuba Singh of Heirok Part II, Thoubal District, Manipur for and in favour of the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, Manipur vide Sale deed dated 23/01/2010. The said Marjit Singh put his signatures on the said sale deed. Further, the said Marjit Singh put his signature on the Memorandum of Consideration Receipt appended in the said sale deed, wherein the said Marjit Singh acknowledged the receipt of a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- as sale price or cost of the land. Again, the said Marjit also put his signature on the Receipt dated 05/02/2010 wherein he acknowledged the receipt of the sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakh) only as sale price or cost of the land from the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District. In consequence of aforesaid transfer of land in favour of the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, the name of Superintendent of Police, Thoubal (Heirok Police Station, Heirok) has been entered in the relevant land records vide the Mutation Case No. 102/SDC/HRK dated 05/04/2010 of the Sub-Deputy Collector, Heirok. In total contradiction to what the said Marjit Singh did as aforesaid, he gave his statement in the enquiry/investigation conducted by the Additional SP (L/O), Thoubal thereby stating that the aforesaid land has no Dag number and Patta number. He further stated that the Government gave no money or amount to him.

It is found that Moirangthem Marjit Singh S/o M. Amuba Singh of Heirok Part-II has given false evidence, false information and committed the offence of cheating after gaining a sum of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakh) only from the Superintendent of Police, Thoubal District, Manipur and he appears to escape from the case concealing the fact.

Hence, a suo-motu case under FIR No. 23(08)2026 HRK PS U/s 318(4)/314/315/61(2)/217/240/229 BNS, 2023 is taken up against the culprit i.e. Moirangthem Marjit Singh 54 years S/o M. Amuba Singh of Heirok Part-II, Thoubal District, Manipur for investigation.
