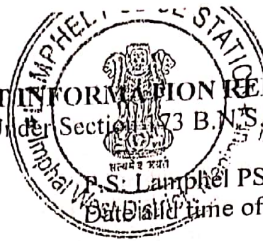

Subject: - Submission of Enquiry report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that, pursuant to the endorsement and with the approval of the senior officers, I conducted an enquiry under G.D. Entry No. 13/LPS/2026 dated 30/05/2026 regarding a complaint lodged by Dr. Laishram Dibamani Singh, husband of Chongtham Meenarani Devi, a resident of Lane No. 14, Lamboikhongnangkhang, Imphal West, Manipur, concerning a series of incidents posing a continuous threat to the lives and safety of his family and himself. The complainant stated that the following incidents had occurred:

1. Incident dated 28/05/2026 (the latest Incident): on 28/05/2026 at about 7:20 PM, the complainant returned home in his car after attending to some personal work. As he entered the residential compound through the gate to park his vehicle, two unknown young males, aged approximately 18 to 25 years, allegedly attempted to force their way into the premises behind his car. However, his wife, who was in the process of closing the gate, managed to lock it immediately, thereby preventing their entry. The two individuals reportedly shouted at her and demanded that she open the gate, which she refused to do.

He further stated that approximately ten minutes later, two persons riding a two-wheeler stopped on the main Uripok-Kangchup Road. One of them allegedly walked down Lane No. 14, slipped a sealed envelope under the closed gate of his residence, and immediately fled. Thereafter, the two-wheeler sped away towards the Iroisemba side. According to the complainant, the entire incident was captured on the CCTV cameras installed at his residence. The envelope was superscribed with: "To, Laishram Dibamani From - KCP Apunba". It appeared to contain 3 (three) bullets/pellets of small arms. Without opening or tampering with the envelope, he submitted the sealed envelope to the police station on 30/05/2026.

2. Prior connected Incident on 22/05/2026: on 22/05/2026 at around 5:00 PM, two masked males on a two-wheeler entered the gate of the complainant residence. At that time, his wife was alone at home and locked the main door from inside for her safety. Failing to gain access to the complainant's house, the individuals allegedly proceeded to his brother's adjacent residence, where they enquired about the complainant and his family members from his sister-in-law. Before leaving, they reportedly provided a mobile phone number, 8731001614, and instructed that the complainant contact them on that number.

3. Prior connected Incident on 02/04/2026: on 02/04/2026 at about 8:30 AM, an unknown male wearing a face mask (who closely resembles the individual from the 28th May incident) trespassed into the complainant compound by opening the gate. At that time, his wife was alone at home. The individual allegedly demanded the mobile phone number of the complainant's wife or those of other family members without disclosing any reason. Upon her refusal, he handed over a mobile number, 7630915054, and threatened her stating, "Your family will face dire consequences if you do not call this number today". Due to fear and security concerns, the family did not contact the number.

The complainant stated that, in view of the above incidents involving trespass, intimidation, and the delivery of suspected live ammunition in the name of a banned organization (KCP Apunba), his family is living under constant fear and perceived an imminent threat to their lives and safety. He therefore requested appropriate legal action against the unknown miscreants and sought an immediate investigation.

During the course of the enquiry, one white-coloured sealed envelope mark as "TO, LAISHRAM DIBAMANI FROM - K.C.P. APUNBA" suspected to be containing of 3 nos. of live ammunitions was seized on production by the complainant, namely Laishram Dibamani Singh, by preparing a seizure memo on 30/05/2026 at 11:45 AM at Lamphel Police Station, after observing all legal formalities in the presence of witnesses.

Visited the place of occurrence and examined the complainant. He fully corroborated the facts stated in his written complaint. Enquiries were also conducted in the surrounding locality. Local residents stated that they had observed two unknown youths covering their

faces with masks and moving around the area on an unidentified scooter in a suspicious manner. However, they were unable to identify the individuals, as their faces were concealed. The witnesses further stated that they had noticed such persons on the dates mentioned by the complainant.

During further enquiry, a requisition was submitted to the Nodal Officer, LIU, Office of the Superintendent of Police, Imphal West, Manipur, vide Memo No. 2061/LPS/2026 dated 30/05/2026, requesting the CAF, CDR, SDR, and present location details of the mobile numbers 8731001614 and 7630915054.
