Subject: - Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that today, i.e., 11/06/2026, at about 05:00 hrs, reliable information was received through own sources regarding the presence of a cadre of the banned organization PLA/RPF in the Langol area under Imphal West District. Upon receipt of the information, the same was immediately conveyed to the Control Room, Imphal West, through Kilo-50.

Acting on the said information, I, along with my team and one civil team under the command of Subedar S. Birla Singh, OC, CDO Unit, Kakching, under the supervision of Shri Amarjit Singh Lamabam, MPS, Addl. SP (Ops), Kakching, and the overall supervision of Smt. Priyadarshini Laishram, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Kakching, rushed to the indicated area and conducted a cordon and search operation at a suspected location near Shija Hospital, Langol.

During the operation, one individual matching the received information was detained near the main gate of Shija Hospital, Langol. On preliminary examination, he identified himself as Shougaijam Zetlison Singh (27 years), S/o Shougaijam Babul Singh of Kakching Khunyai Leikai, Kakching District.

Upon sustained questioning, he disclosed that he was an active member of the banned organization PLA/RPF and had joined the outfit through one self-styled Commander Sanjit of the said organization. He further stated that he had been working under the command of the said cadre. Based on his disclosure and available evidence, he was arrested at the spot at about 7:45 p.m. after observing all legal formalities.

From his possession, one Redmi Note 14 5G mobile phone bearing IMEI Nos. 865541072586222 and 865541072586230, along with one JIO SIM card bearing mobile number 8247420548, was recovered and seized at about 7:50 p.m. after observing all legal formalities. Videography of the seizure proceedings was also conducted at the spot.

During further investigation, he revealed that arms, ammunition, and explosive materials had been handed over to him by Yengkhom Sarjit Singh of Kakching Paji Leikai, Kakching, with instructions to conceal the said items.

Based on this disclosure, teams of CDO Unit, Kakching immediately proceeded to Kakching Paji Leikai and conducted a search at the residence of Yengkhom Sarjit Singh. Upon verification, he identified himself as Yengkhom Sarjit Singh (21 years), S/o Yengkhom Bishwajit Singh of Kakching Paji Leikai, Kakching.

After due verification, he was arrested at the spot at about 9:25 p.m. after observing all legal formalities. From his possession, one Redmi mobile phone bearing IMEI Nos. 866633084532200 and 866633084532218, along with one Airtel SIM card bearing mobile number 9612087951, was recovered and seized at about 9:32 p.m. after observing all legal formalities. Photography of the seizure proceedings was also carried out at the spot.

During sustained interrogation, both arrested persons disclosed that they had concealed arms, ammunition, and other incriminating materials in a traditional thatched hut located in front of the residence of Shougaijam Zetlison Singh at Kakching Khunyai Leikai.

Accordingly, the team proceeded to the residence of Shougaijam Zetlison Singh at Kakching Khunyai Leikai and conducted a search operation. During the search, the arrested individual pointed out the concealed arms and ammunition. The team recovered one black-coloured leather bag concealed inside a wooden box. Upon opening the bag, suspected arms, ammunition, and IED-related materials were found.

Immediately, CID-Tech and SBDDS were informed through Kakching Police Station. Upon their arrival, the recovered items were examined and formally seized after observing

all legal formalities. Videography of the entire search and seizure proceedings was also conducted at the spot.

The following items were recovered and seized:

1. One 9 mm pistol with empty magazine bearing Body No. 5906, made in USA.
2. Eleven (11) rounds of 9 mm live ammunition.
3. Four (4) rounds of .303 live ammunition.
4. Three (3) rounds of AK live ammunition.
5. One (1) 12-bore cartridge.
6. Four (4) detonators.
7. Two (2) remote-control devices suspected to be used for IEDs.
8. One (1) remote control.
9. One (1) Nokia battery bearing No. 000060011614S44D8EE3.
10. One (1) PLA flag.
11. One (1) leather side bag Black in colour.
12. One (1) black polythene bag.
13. Torn carbon paper.

The seizure was effected at about 11:33 p.m after observing all legal formalities. During further questioning regarding the recovered arms, ammunition, and IED-related materials, both arrested persons disclosed that the items had been concealed under the instructions of self-styled Commander Sanjit of the banned organization PLA/RPF. Videography of the seizure proceedings was conducted at the spot.

Thereafter, the arrested persons along with the seized articles were handed over to the Officer-in-Charge, Lamphel Police Station, for registration of a case and further necessary legal action.
