Subject: - Submission of Enquiry report.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that on 20/06/2026 at about 8:11 AM, a team from CDO, Imphal West (Call Sign: PAPA-55) arrived at Lamphel Police Station. The Team Commander, SI Robash of CDO, Imphal West, handed over *"some broken fragments of a green plastic-bodied grenade-like object, consisting of pieces of the outer plastic casing, a safety lever-like metal piece, and other internal components"*. He reported that the said articles had been collected from the residence of Mairembam Chandra Singh, aged 65 years, son of Late M. Modhu Singh, a resident of Sagaiprou Mamang Leikai, Maning Lampak, who is presently serving as the Principal of Imphal College.

As reported by Mairembam Chandra Singh, the said fragments were discovered by him at about 5:00 AM on 20/06/2026 in the open space (front yard) within the compound of his residence. Upon receiving the information, the CDO team visited the spot, collected the suspected grenade fragments, and subsequently handed them over to Lamphel Police Station.

Accordingly, as per the endorsement of the Officer-in-Charge, Lamphel Police Station, an enquiry was conducted in c/w the above-mentioned General Diary entry. The said *"some broken fragments of a green plastic-bodied grenade-like object, consisting of pieces of the outer plastic casing, a safety lever-like metal piece, and other internal components"*, were deposited in the Malkhana of Lamphel Police Station vide M.R. No. 939/LPS/2026 dated 20/06/2026 for safe custody.

Thereafter, visited the residence of Mairembam Chandra Singh aged 65 years, s/o Late M. Modhu Singh, located at Sagaiprou Mamang Leikai, Maning Lampak and examined him. During the examination, he stated that he is presently serving as the Principal of Imphal College. He further stated that on 20/06/2026 at about 5:00 AM, he noticed some suspicious materials scattered in the front yard of his residence. Upon closer inspection, the materials appeared to be broken fragments of a green plastic-bodied grenade-like object. When he enquired with his family members, none of them had any knowledge of how the fragments had come to be there. However, his younger son, Mairembam Frankko, informed him that he had heard a faint sound resembling that of a "Bambula" firecracker at about 2:00 AM on the same day. As the sound was not very loud, he did not come outside to verify its source. Thereafter, Mairembam Chandra Singh informed the CDO, Imphal West, following which a team from CDO arrived at his residence, collected the broken fragments, and left the premises.

During the examination, Mairembam Chandra Singh was asked whether he had received any threats or demands from any unlawful organisation or criminal group. In response, he stated that approximately two months prior to the incident, two unknown young men with their faces covered by masks came to his office at Imphal College. They instructed him to collect money from every teacher of the college and hand it over to them as a party fund. When he questioned them about the reason for covering their faces and asked them to disclose the name of their organisation, they became angry, refused to reveal the name of their outfit, and left the college premises.

During the course of the enquiry, reliable source information was received indicating that the act of hurling a green plastic-bodied grenade-like object into the compound of the residence of Mairembam Chandra Singh, Principal of Imphal College, where it subsequently exploded, was allegedly carried out by members of the unlawful organisation PREPAK. The said source information is being verified through further investigation.

I, therefore, submit this enquiry report for your kind perusal and for taking further necessary action as deemed fit.
