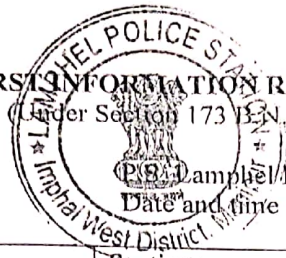

Subject: Complaint regarding house-breaking, theft, and attempted house trespass by unknown person(s).

Sir,

I, Laishram Dhaneshwari Devi, aged about 64 years, wife of Maibam Prafullo Chandra Singh, resident of Changangei Makha Leikai, P.S. Lamphel, Imphal West, Manipur, most respectfully submit this complaint as follows:

That on 08/07/2026, at about 10:30 a.m, I left my residence for Khangabok after properly locking the main gate, the main entrance door, and all the rooms of my house. My son is presently employed and residing at Noida, and my daughter is married and lives separately. Therefore, only my husband and I reside in the said house.

At about 7:30 p.m on the same day, I returned home from Khangabok. After opening the lock of the main gate and entering the house premises, I noticed that the key which had been secured in the lock of the main entrance door had been removed/broken by some unknown person(s) and was found lying on the nearby sofa inside the house. Suspecting foul play, I immediately entered the house and switched on the lights. I found that several household articles had been scattered and disturbed. Upon further inspection, I noticed that the doors of some rooms had been partially damaged, indicating that an attempt had been made to forcibly gain entry into those rooms.

Thereafter, I discovered that one gold necklace weighing approximately 19 (nineteen) san, which had been kept inside the drawer of our common room, was missing. I strongly suspect that the same was stolen by the unknown person(s) who unlawfully entered my house.

I further wish to state that a similar incident had occurred at my residence on 16/05/2026, during which some unknown person(s) allegedly stole approximately Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs) in cash from my house. However, due to personal reasons, I did not lodge any complaint with the police at that time.

In view of the above facts, I humbly request you to kindly register a case, conduct a thorough investigation, trace and apprehend the unknown culprit(s), recover the stolen gold necklace and any other stolen property, and take appropriate legal action against the offender(s) in accordance with law so that such incidents do not recur in future.

I shall remain grateful for your prompt and necessary action.

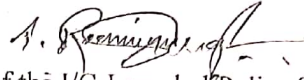

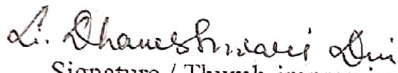

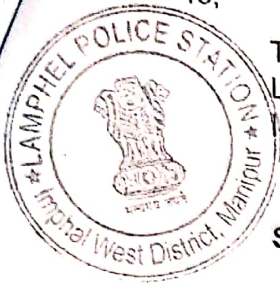
