

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 13th August, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 13.08.2026, during a search operation at Kallenjang village under Senapati-PS, Senapati district, security forces recovered the following:
 - i. 05 (five) SBBL,
 - ii. 01 (one) 9 mm Pistol,
 - iii. 02 (two) Chinese hand grenades,
 - iv. 13 (thirteen) rounds of different calibres, and
 - v. 33 (thirty three) empty cases.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 13.08.2026, Security forces arrested an active cadre of RPF/PLA, one Ningthoujam Khema Meitei alias Inao (49) of Ningthouta Chandon Pokpi, Bishnupur district from Kakching Irumpal area under Kakching-PS, Kakching district.
 2. On 13.08.2026, Security forces arrested an active cadre of RPF/PLA, one Amom Ingocha Singh alias Chumthang (57) of Wangoo Heinouyam Awang Leikai, Kakching from his residence.
 3. On 12.08.2026, Manipur Police arrested an extortionist active cadre of KCP (MJC), one Longjam Arjun alias Naobi (38) of Samurou Makha Leikai a/p Senjam Chirang from his current locality under Sekmai-PS, Imphal West district.
 4. On 12.08.2026, security forces arrested an active cadre s/s Lance Corporal of RPF/PLA, one Wahengbam Apoicha Meitei alias Maikel (45) of Hiyanglam Awang Leikai, Kakching District from his locality.
 5. On 12.08.2026, based on specific input, Thoubal CDO teams launched a search ops in general area Sapam, Khongjom-PS, during which an extortionist active cadre of KYKL, one Chongtham Premchand Singh (41) was arrested.
 6. On 12/08/2026, a UNLF (Koireng) cadre involved in a kidnapping and shooting case, namely Yumkhaibam Brojen (51) of Sajirok Mayai Leikai, Imphal West, was arrested by CDO-BPR from his locality under Patsoi-PS.
 7. On 13/08/2026, during a search operation, a team of CDO-IW arrested a member of RPF/PLA namely Ningombam Ibomcha Meetei (58) alias Biramangol of Sagolband Mabudhou Mantri Leikai, Imphal West District from his residence.
 8. On 12.08.26, two CCLs were apprehended by security forces for being members of UKNA from Khengjang village, Churachandpur.
From the duo, following items were recovered:
 - i. 01 (One) AK with magazine,
 - ii. 12 (Twelve) rounds of 7.62 mm,
 - iii. 01 (One) 9 mm pistol with magazine,
 - iv. 01 (One) Baofeng radio set,
 - v. 01 (One) Royal Enfield bike.

9. During an operation at Joupi and Khoirok villages, Kangpokpi District on 12/08/2026, joint teams of Manipur Police, CRPF, CoBRA and RAF recovered arms and ammunition and miscellaneous items including the following:

- i) 01 (One) .22 rifle with magazine,
- ii) 05 (Five) Single Barrel Guns,
- iii) 04 (Four) Walkie Talkie sets,
- iv) 06 (Six) Walkie Talkie chargers,
- v) 158 (One Hundred Fifty Eight) 12 Bore cartridges,
- vi) 06 (Six) empty cases.

Two residents of Joupi Village were also apprehended during the search operation:

- i. Henminthang Haokip (31) and
- ii. Jamminlal Kipgen (25).

IV. On 13.08.2026, Manipur Police arrested one Imliakum Longkumer (46) of Longa Village, PO&PS Mokokchung Nagaland along with 37 soap cases weighing 446 grams and one Four-Wheeler Bolero from Khongnem Thana village while conducting frisking and checking under Senapati-PS, Senapati district.

V. On 13-08-2026, a joint operation comprising teams of Churachandpur District Police and CRPF, in coordination with local women CSOs was launched at T. Khajang Village and adjoining areas under Singhat-PS.
During the operation an illegal distillery was located and destroyed along with around 2,000 litres of DIC liquor.

Other recovery during the operation include:

- i. 19 Metal pots,
- ii. 24 small drums, and
- iii. 2 boxes of dry yeast.

VI. Movement of **817** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.

VII. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.

VIII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
