

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 27th August, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 26/08/2026, based on a reliable information and corroborated with 33 AR, a team of CDO-IW conducted search operation at Brahmapur Aribam Leikai, Imphal East and arrested one active member of KCP (PWG) from his residence, namely Aribam Shivashwor Sharma (25) alias Mellow s/o (L) A. Nilabara Sharma.
 2. On 26.08.2026, based on a reliable information and corroborated with 33 AR, a team of CDO-IE arrested Ningthoujam Joyshana alias Joy (28), an active member of RPF/PLA, from Kongba Laishram Leikai, Imphal East.
 3. On 27/08/2026, Special CDO Unit arrested a cadre of UPPK (United People's Party of Kangleipak) namely Elangbam Robichandra Singh (47) S/o. E. Kumar Singh of Hiyanglam Mayai Leikai, Kakching District from his residence. The arrestee had recruited a Hiyanglam Warkhong resident in the proscribed group.
- IV. On 26/08/2026, based on reliable intelligence, a joint team of ANTF/Imphal East-District Police, CRPF and Kangpokpi District Police conducted an anti-narcotics operation at Khoiren Tampak, Motbung under Gamnom Saparmeina-PS, Kangpokpi and arrested Paocha Kipgen (32), r/o Phoibih village, Motbung.
Seizure:
 1. Approx. 2.35 kg suspected Brown Sugar,
 2. One Bajaj diesel auto (MN03W1971) and
 3. One mobile phone.
- V. On 26.08.2026, while conducting frisking and checking at T Khullen Naka Check Post, a combined team of SOT Senapati Police, D-78 CRPF, QAT B-109 and 16 AR arrested one Muhammad Safiqur Rahaman (23) S/o Muhammad Riyajuddin of Lilong Haoreibi Turul Ahanbi, Thoubal district.
From his possession, inter alia, the following were seized:
 1. 27 (twenty seven) soap cases suspected to be Brown sugar weighing 360 gm,
 2. One vehicle Omni (WB 64T 7355).

- VI. A total of **112** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
