

PRESS NOTE
Imphal, the 30th August, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
 1. On 29.08.2026, a combined team of Bishnupur District Police and Security Forces recovered the following items from Keipha Road Patton near Water Supply Pump:
 - i. One 9 mm pistol with magazine,
 - ii. One .32 pistol with magazine,
 - iii. One country-made AK rifle with magazine,
 - iv. One country-made MP-9 with magazine,
 - v. One country-made SBBL,
 - vi. One country-made .22 rifle with magazine,
 - vii. Two No. 36 hand grenades,
 - viii. Two IEDs,
 - ix. Ammunition of various calibres and other accessories.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
 1. On 29.08.2026, a combined team of Thoubal District Police and Security Forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (PWG) namely, Laishram Abem Devi (37), W/o. Mayengbam Anand Singh of Wabagai Awang Leikai under Kakching-PS, Kakching District from Nambashi Horton (Ningel Lamkhai) area under Nongpok Sekmai-PS, Thoubal District.
 2. On 29.08.2026, a combined team of Thoubal District Police and Security Forces arrested an active cadre of KCP (PWG) namely, Loukham Santa Singh (32) S/o. (L) L. Hembra Singh of Yairipok Malom Mayai Leikai under Yairipok-PS Thoubal District from Kakmayai Lamkhai area under Nongpok Sekmai-PS, Thoubal District.
 3. On 29.08.2026, based on reliable intelligence corroborated by 7 Madras Regiment, CDO/Imphal East arrested Moirangthem Premgeet Meitei @ Naocha (27), an active member of KYKL, from Irilbung Thongkhong, Imphal East.

He was involved in the recruitment of an 18 year old into KYKL. The youth was rescued from the spot before being handed over to the outfit.
 4. On 29.08.2026, a combined team of CDO Unit Kakching and 46 AR Kakching arrested an active cadre of KYKL, one Yumnam Rohenjit Meitei @ Akui (26) S/o Yumnam Ibomcha Meitei of Langmeidong Maning Mayai Leikai, Kakching District from his residence. His accomplice in extortion activities, namely Shakachand Yumnam @ Chand (26) S/o Yumnam Ibobi Singh of Langmeidong Mamang Leikai was also arrested from his residence at Langmeidong Mamang Leikai along with the following:
 - i. 02 (two) Empty INSAS Magazine,
 - ii. 27 (twenty Seven) INSAS live rounds,
 - iii. 01 (one) BAOFENG handset,
 - iv. 02 (two) Slings,
 - v. 01 (one) BP Jacket with 1 (one) single Plate,
 - vi. 01 (one) pair of Tactical boot and
 - vii. 01 (one) Magazine pouch.

- IV. On 29.08.2026, Bishnupur District Police during routine frisking and checking duty at Sericulture Training, under Phougakchao Ithai PS arrested two drug peddlers along with five soap cases of Heroin No. 4 weighing about 53 grams:
1) Md. Amir Khan, aged about 34 years, S/o Md. Yakum Ali of Kwakta Ward No. 3 and
2) Md. Bungo aged about 33 years S/o Md Habibur of Kwakta Pungal Lamkhai.
One two wheeler Suzuki Burgman street 125 CC was also seized.
- V. As per requisition from T8 - Guduvanchery Police Station, Tamil Nadu, in connection with a case, police support was sought to trace two accused persons who were suspected to be hiding and taking shelter in Jiribam area.
One of the accused, Manik Uddin Laskar (22) S/o Monir Uddin Laskar of Sonabarighat, Sonai, Cachar, Assam was arrested from Inter-Village Road of Lalpani to Rasidpur, Jiribam, on 28/08/2026. The co-accused Bhagabati Majhi @ Ayesha Begum (21) W/o Manik Uddin Laskar & D/o Chatoray Majhi of Radhapur Village, PS-Saharpada, District Kendujhar, Odisha was also arrested from Kashimpur Village, Jiribam, on 29/08/2026 by the joint team of Jiribam District Police and Tamil Nadu Police.
The arrested persons are being handed over to the SHO, T8 - Guduvanchery Police Station, Tamil Nadu for further necessary formalities.
- VI. On 30.08.2026, a team of Chassad Police Station detected 30 litres of Local DIC liquor from one Tata truck driver namely Mr. Rafikuddin (45) s/o Mr. Habibur Rahman of Kanakpur part 1 Binnakandi, Cachar Assam. The liquor was later destroyed by the team and Kamjong Womenfolk near the PS gate.
- VII. Manipur Police continue its drive to curb motor vehicle offences:
- From 24.08.2026 to 30.08.2026, Manipur Police issued **125 (one hundred twenty five)** challans to motor vehicle offenders, amounting a total of **Rs. 1,07,000/- (one lakh seven thousand) only.**
 - From 24.08.2026 to 30.08.2026, tinted films from **20 (twenty)** vehicles were removed and **02 (two)** vehicles were seized.
- VIII. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.
- IX. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
