Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that on 27/04/2026 at around 10.00 am an information was received from my own source regarding transportation of some illegal contraband drugs in a Tata Truck bearing regn. No. PB06V-0725 from Imphal to Cachar, Assam side along NH-37. Accordingly, I had recorded the statement of the source man and reduced in writing and a similar copy of the source report is also submitted to the Superintendent of Police, Jiribam, Manipur (through proper channel) for necessary information. As such, I obtained search authorization from SP/JBM and immediately, acting on that information a combined team of Jiribam District Police, Jiribam -PS, CDO/Unit, Jiribam, Special Mobile Patrol, Unit, Jiribam Dett. -48 Bn. CRPF, 87 Bn. CRPF, QAT Dett. 20 Bn. CRPF, QAT-156 Bn. CRPF, and 38 Assam Rifles under the supervision of Shri, Prakhari Pandey (IPS) SP, Jiribam rushed at Leingangpokpi village, Jiribam along NH-37 and started conducting frisking and checking of vehicles plying at the said area. At around 7.45 pm the above noted Tata Truck bearing regn. No. PB06V-0725 arrived at the said spot driven by one unknown person later identified as Sukhvinder Singh (DoB- 01/01/1996) S/O. Balvinder Singh of Mari Udhoke, PO & PS- Khanra, Dist.- Tarn Taran, Punjab-143305 along with a co-occupant namely Sandeep Singh Tilno (DoB- 01/01/1985) S/O. Harjeet Singh of Gudiyan Purwa, Tanda Nijamali, PO & PS-Fateh Pur, Dist.- Bara Banki, Uttar Pradesh-225305. Option report was provided to the said driver u/s 50 ND & PS Act and he chose to be search by Executive Magistrate. Immediately, I informed the matter with Shri. Noor Kamaal Sheikh (MPS), SDPO/JBM. In no time, SDPO, Jiribam along with Shri, Jitendra Prasad Keer, IPS (P), OC/JBM-PS and Shri. Abdul Kalam, Executive Magistrate, Jiribam arrived at the place. The vehicle was thoroughly checked in presence of Executive Magistrate, Jiribam and 02 (two) witnesses. On checking the said vehicle 50 packets wrapped with plastic were found hidden inside the compartment of Oil Tank suspected to be Opium.

On removing the said packets from the oil tank of the said truck in front of the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam and weighing it was found i.e., A-1= 1.019 kg, A-2= 1.008 kg, A-3= 1.007 kg, A-4=1.019 kg, A-5= 1.018 kg, A-6=1.023 kg, A-7= 1.017 kg, A-8= 1.015 kg, A-9=1.020 kg, A-10=1.021 kg, A-11=1.021 kg, A-12=1.024 kg, A-13=1.016 kg, A-14=1.016 kg, A-15=1.015 kg, A-16=1.015 kg, A-17=1.017 kg, A-18=1.020 kg, A-19=1.019 kg, A-20=1.018 kg, A-21=1.014 kg, A-22=1.019 kg, A-23=1.017 kg, A-24=1.016 kg, A-25=1.014 kg, A-26= 1.015 kg, A-27=1.016 kg, A-28=1.013 kg, A-29=1.019 kg, A-30=1.018 kg, A-31=1.015 kg, A-32=1.018 kg, A-33=1.019 kg, A-34=1.015 kg, A-35=1.013 kg, A-36=1.019 kg, A-37=1.018 kg, A-38=1.010 kg, A-39=1.015 kg, A-40=1.015 kg, A-41=1.020 kg, A-42=1.017 kg, A-43=1.014 kg, A-44=1.015 kg, A-45=1.016 kg, A-46=1.014 kg, A-47=1.017 kg, A-48=1.015 kg, A-49=1.015 kg, A-50=1.000 kg, **(altogether approx. 50.809 kgs, measured on the spot conditions, valued at approx. 5 Crores in international market)**. The packets were then put inside 02 (two) cartoon boxes and packed and sealed using white colour plain cloth and marked as "X-I" (containing A-1 to A-36) and "X-II" (containing A-37 to A-50).

The parent packet marked as "X-I" and "X-II" are then signed by self, witnesses namely (1) Sawaijam Abee Singh (55) yrs S/O. (L) S. Kula Singh of Leingangpokpi, Jiribam and (2) HC. Chingnangkomba Luwang of SMPU, Jiribam and the accused persons. Now, the following articles were seized at 12.05 am of today i.e., 28/04/2026 by observing necessary formalities:

- (i) The 02 (two) cartoon boxes wrapped with white colour plain clothes, packed and sealed containing 50.809 kgs. of Opium marked as "X-I" and "X-II".
- (ii) Tata truck bearing regn no. PB06V-0725.
- (iii) One mobile phone handset (Vivo V27)
- (iv) One mobile phone handset (Vivo V29)
- (v) One mobile phone handset (POCO)



Further, the above noted accused persons were arrested at 12.15 am of today i.e., 28/04/2026 as well as the ground of arrest u/s. 47(1) BNSS are served to the accused persons and also information regarding their arrest were given to their family members telephonically.

It is, therefore, the seized items along with the arrested persons are hereby handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.
