Sir,

Most humbly and respectfully, with referred to the above cited reference I would like to submit herewith an enquiry report in c/w the written report filed by SI. E. Dorendro Singh i/c. CDO Unit Jiribam stating that on 28/04/2026 at around 5.25 pm while he along with his team were performing normal frisking and checking duty at Lamkhair Bazar area. Meanwhile, 2 (two) nos. of light goods vehicles loaded with some goods approached towards the frisking and checking point from Jiribam Bazar side. Seeing the vehicles the checking party sign to stop the vehicle, but instead of slowing down both the vehicles are speed-up and flee by avoiding the checking party. In no time, I along with my team chased both the vehicle and overtake at Sorok Atingbi Kamranga area and stopped both the vehicles Tata Yodha bearing regd. no. (i) AS 11 FC - 3728, and (ii) AS 11 GC - 0388 loaded with nos. of sack bags containing Betel-leaf. On seeing the police party, 2 (two) unknown persons trying to escaped from the place, but the police team overpower one of them and managed to nab and the other manage to escaped towards Jiri River. Then, the detainee identified himself as one N. Kenedy Singh @ Poupangai (35) yrs S/O. N. Binoykumar Singh of Kalinagar ward no. 1, P.O. P.S & Dist. Jiribam, Manipur.

Accordingly, the detainee has been preliminary examined and on examination he disclosed that, he is an active member of ZUF-J (Jenchui) faction and he along with 2 (two) others members of the same outfit namely (i) Zems and (ii) David of Tamenglong were trying to execute extortion from the above mention vehicles i.e. Tata Yodha bearing regd. no. (i) AS 11 FC - 3728, and (ii) AS 11 GC - 0388 loaded with nos. of sack bag containing Betel-leaf and both the vehicles were picked-up from the Chandrapur oil pump (while the vehicles are re-fueling). Moreover, the 2 (two) drivers of the vehicles are examined and there statement are also fully corroborated with the commission of the incident. On the other hand, one Realme mobile phone model C75 5G and a sum of Rs. 500 X 32 = 16,000 (which is highly suspected to be extorted money) is been recovered from the detainee. But, the detainee is reluctant to disclosed the source of recovery amount. As such, the above recovery items are seized from his possession by preparing a formal seizure memo at 10.45 pm and also arrested at 10.50 pm by observing formalities. A copy ground of arrest U/S. 47(1) BNSS is also served to the arrested person and arrest information is also given to their family members telephonically.

It is, therefore, the seized items and the arrested person are hereby handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.
