Subject: Report.

Sir,

I have the honour to report that on 29/06/2026 at around 1.00 pm an information was received from my own source regarding transportation of some illegal contraband drugs in a Hundai i20 vehicle bearing regn. No. GJ27BL-0847 from Imphal to Cachar, Assam side along NH-37. Accordingly, I had recorded the statement of the source man and reduced in writing and a similar copy of the source report is also submitted to the Superintendent of Police, Jiribam, Manipur (through proper channel) for necessary information. As such, I obtained search authorization from SP/JBM and immediately, acting on that information a combined team of Jiribam District Police led by Shri. Th. Kamaljit Singh (MPS) Addl. Supdt. of Police (L/O), Jiribam, Jiribam -PS, Special Mobile Patrol, Unit, Jiribam Dett. -48 Bn. CRPF, QAT-156 Bn. CRPF, under the supervision of Shri. Prakhar Pandey (IPS) SP, Jiribam rushed at Leingangpokpi village, Jiribam along NH-37 and started conducting frisking and checking of vehicles plying at the said area. At around 6.50 pm the above noted Hundai i20 vehicle bearing regn. No. GJ27BL-0847 arrived at the said spot driven by one unknown person later identified as Dhanraj Prajapat (DoB- 05/04/1980) S/O. Kachru Lal of Sanchai, PO-Chittorgah, PS- Pratapgarh, Dist.- Pratapgarh, Rajasthan-312605 along with a co-occupant namely Buddha Ram (DoB- 01/01/1982) S/O. Naina Ram of Dawal, PO- Jalor, PS- Chitalwana, Dist.- Jalor, Rajasthan-343027. Option report was provided to the said driver u/s 50 ND & PS Act and he chose to be search by Executive Magistrate. Immediately, I informed the matter with Shri. Noor Kamaal Sheikh (MPS), SDPO/JBM. In no time, SDPO, Jiribam and Shri. Md. Hefajuddin, Executive Magistrate, Jiribam arrived at the place. The vehicle was thoroughly checked in presence of Executive Magistrate, Jiribam and 02 (two) witnesses. On checking the said vehicle 05 (five) packets wrapped with plastic transparent Cello Tap were found hidden inside the Rocker Panel of the said vehicle suspected to be Opium.

On removing the said packets from the Hundai i20 vehicle in front of the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam and weighing it was found i.e., A-1=.952 kg, A-2=1.074 kg, A-3=1.202 kg, A-4=.771 kg, A-5=1.146 kg, **(altogether approx. 5.145 kgs, measured on the spot conditions valued at approx. 1 Crore in international market)**. The packets were then put inside one cartoon box and packed and sealed using white colour plain cloth and marked as "A".

The parent packet marked as "A" is then signed by self, witnesses namely (1) C/No. 0183110 L. Alex Singh of SMPU, Jiribam and (2) Aribam Kenedy Sharma (DoB- 22/11/1992) S/O. A. Babuton Sharma of Dibong Makha Leikai, Jiribam and the accused persons. Now, the following articles were seized at 8.05 pm of today i.e., 29/06/2026 by observing necessary formalities:

- (i) **The one cartoon box wrapped with white colour plain clothes, packed and sealed containing 5.145 kgs. of suspected to be Opium marked as "A".**
- (ii) **Hundai i20 bearing regn no. GJ27BL-0847.**
- (iii) **One Mobile phone handset (Moto g4S 5G)**
- (iv) **One Mobile Phone handset (Vivo Y19s 5G)**
- (v) **One Mobile phone handset (iPhone 11)**
- (vi) **98 (ninety eight) nos. of 500 rupee notes (98x500=Rs. 49,000/-).**
- (vii) **07 (seven) nos. of 100 rupee notes (7x100=Rs. 700/-).**
- (viii) **03 (three) nos. of 50 rupee notes (3x50=Rs. 150/-).**
- (ix) **01 (one) no. of 20 rupee note (1x20=Rs. 20/-).**
- (x) **04 (four) nos. of 10 rupee notes (4x10=Rs. 40/-)**

Further, the above noted accused persons were arrested at 8.15 pm of today i.e., 29/06/2026 as well as the ground of arrest u/s. 47(1) BNSS are served to the accused persons and also information regarding their arrest were given to their family members telephonically.

It is, therefore, the seized items along with the arrested persons are hereby handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.
