Sir,

Most I have the honour to state that today i.e., on 17/07/2026 at about 10.30 am, while I along with my team were at DC office, Jiribam performing my normal duty, in the meantime one of my source man informed me regarding one person namely Mr. Kulla who is doing business of contraband Ganja at his own house located at Lakhipur Chingkha, Jiribam. Accordingly, the said information is reduced in writing and placed before the Superintendent of Police Jiribam District, Manipur. As such, I had obtained the house search authorization from SP/JBM and immediately, acting on the secret information I along with my team along with my source man rush at the said location for execution under the supervision of Shri, Prakhari Pandey (IPS) SP, Jiribam. As pointed out by my source man one house located at Lakhipur Chingkha ward no. 9, Jiribam near PHE water supply pump had been cordoned and found the said house and the outhouse (sangoi) are under lock & key. In no time, I along with my team led by Addl. SP (L/O) Jiribam Shri. Th. Kamaljit Singh, MPS assisted by a team of Jiribam Police Station and SMPU, Jiribam including my source man were carried out search for the owner of the said house namely Mr. Kulla in the various vicinity places at Jiribam area. Then, on the same day at @ 11.55 am my source man identified the said Mr. Kulla at Jiribam Bazar near fish market and detained him. Thereafter, the said detainee was identified himself as Konjengbam Kulla Singh aged about 47 yrs S/O. (L) K. Biren Singh of Lakhipur Chingkha ward no. 9, Jiribam. Further, I have explained to him that, as information some suspected articles were kept concealed inside his house, so to co-operate while searching his house. In which, the said detainee disclosed that, he had kept conceal some contraband Ganja inside his house and his outhouse (sangoi). As such, the said detainee was brought at his house. Further, I have briefed the detainee about the provisions of section 50 NDPS Act, 1985 in Manipuri language and informed about his legal right that that searched can be conducted before Magistrate/Gazetted Officer or Civil/Independent witnesses if he so desire. A notice U/S 50 NDPS Act was also served to the detainee in which he opted to be searched before the Magistrate.

On the other hand, I have approach to several houses located nearby the said house and requested for witnessing while conducting the search of the house as well as while observing other necessary formalities, but no any civilian is found for witnessing. In the meantime, one Executive Magistrate, Jiribam namely Shri. Abdul Kalam also arrived at the location as deputed by DC, Jiribam. Meanwhile, one lady identified herself as wife of the detainee namely K. Ibemhal had arrived at the location. Thereafter, I along with my team assisted by SI. Ch. Somorjit Singh of JBM-PS along with the said detainee and the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam entered inside the campus of the said house by covering with videography by Rfn. No. 072019006 Th. Nashes Singh of my team.

Then, the lock & key house is been open by the key and on searching of one room left side of the main door one packet wrapped with blue colour polythene containing dried herbs in compact is found kept on the table and another 3 (three) plastic container (white in colour) are also found concealing under the table. On, opening of the said packet it is found containing dried herbs in compact highly suspected to be contraband Ganja which is marked as "A". Again, on opening of the 3 (three) plastic containers it is also found containing with same highly suspected to be contraband Ganja which are marked as "B" (with no lid), "C", & "D". Further, the said out house (sangoi) which is under lock & key is opened and carried out

searching. On searching another packet wrapped with blue colour polythene containing dried herbs in compact is found above the bamboo rack and on further searching 4 (four) another plastic container (white in colour) are also found underneath the said bamboo rack. On opening all of it one after another it are all found containing dried herbs highly suspected to be contraband Ganja which all are marked as "E", "F", "G" (with no lid), "H", & "I". Further, one plastic Jumbo box (blue in colour) is also found above the said bamboo rack which is marked as "J" and on opening it is found many loss dried herbs which is also highly suspected to be contraband Ganja. Then, all the loss dried herbs suspected to be contraband Ganja are put inside 5 (five) separate transparent plastic bags and subsequently marked as "J-1", "J-2", "J-3", "J-4" & "J-5" respectively.

Meanwhile, one Digital weighing scale made of Philips max weight upto 100 kgs had been brought from Jiribam Police Station at the place of occurrence for conducting weighing of the contraband Ganja. As such, the weighing of all the marked items are carried out by using the said Digital weighing scale and found "A"= 10.290 kgs, "B"= 1.810 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "C"= 0.910 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "D"= 1.370 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "E"= 10.380 kgs, "F"= 1.970 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "G"= 1.210 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "H"= 3.100 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "I"= 0.360 kgs (excluding the weight of plastic container), "J-1"= 5.030 kgs, "J-2"= 10.570 kgs, "J-3"= 4.930 kgs, "J-4"= 3.370 kgs, & "J-5"=1.450 kgs. **The total weight of all the packets i.e. "A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J-1, J-2, J-3, J-4 & J-5" is 56.750 kgs.**

Thereafter, the packets marked as "A" & "E" are wrapped with plain white clothes with packed & sealed by using wax. Then, the plastic container (white in colour) marked as "B", "C", "D", "F", "G", "H" & "I" are wrapped the opening lid with plain white clothes with packed & sealed by using wax. Lastly, the plastic Jumbo box (blue in colour) which is marked as "J" is also wrapped the opening lid with plain white clothes with packed & sealed by using wax after putting inside the 5 (five) separate transparent plastic bags marked as "J-1", "J-2", "J-3", "J-4" & "J-5".

Accordingly, the said detainee had been arrested at 3.10 pm from his house for possessing contraband Ganja. Then, I have seized all the packed & sealed articles i.e. "A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J-1, J-2, J-3, J-4 & J-5" from the possession/production of the arrested accused person by preparing a formal seizure memo at 3.15 pm in presence of witnesses and the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam. Later, myself along with the arrested accused person including the witnesses and the Executive Magistrate, Jiribam were appended our respective signatures in all the packed & sealed articles. Then, the ground of arrest U/S. 47(1) BNSS had been served to the accused person and also given arrest information to his wife namely K. Ibemhal Devi by receiving acknowledgement counter signature on the same day.

It is, therefore, the seized items along with the arrested person are hereby handed over to you for taking further necessary legal action.

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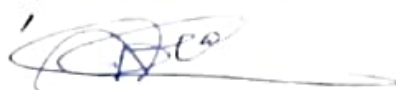
