

PRESS NOTE  
Imphal, the 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2026

- I. The overall law-and-order situation in the state during the last 24 hours was normal.
- II. Security forces continue to conduct search operations and area domination in the fringe and vulnerable areas across districts resulting in recovery of arms and ammunition:
  1. On 04.08.2026, security forces recovered from floating biomass (Phumdi) near the Sendra Hill area of Loktak Lake under Moirang-PS, Bishnupur district, the following:
    - i) 01 (one) .32 pistol with magazine,
    - ii) 01 (one) SBBL gun,
    - iii) 01 (one) .22 bolt-action rifle,
    - iv) 01 (one) Jefferson rifle with magazine,
    - v) 09 (nine) locally made CMG (carbine) firearms with magazine,
    - vi) 02 (two) locally made MP-5 firearms with magazine,
    - vii) 03 (three) locally made Lathode guns,
    - viii) 02 (two) Pompi guns,
    - ix) 06 (six) IED packets and
    - x) Miscellaneous accessories.
- III. Intelligence based combing, cordon and search operations are being carried out extensively to nab those involved in extortion and criminal activities in the state:
  1. On 03.08.2026, Manipur Police arrested an active cadre of KCP (Apunba), one Major Arambam Bobo Singh (42) of Wangoo Mameiching from his residence under Wangoo-PS, Kakching district.
  2. On 04.08.2026, Manipur Police arrested two extortionists, suspected NSCN (IM) cadres from Sibilong along NH-37 under Kaimai-PS, Tamenglong district:
    - i) Gaisuaklung Ngaomei (45) of Bhalok village, Bhalok, Tamenglong district and
    - ii) Job Gangmei (29) of Sibilong Pt-II, Tousem Sub-Division, Tamenglong district.From their possession, the following were seized:
    - i) 01 (One) cartridge bullet,
    - ii) A sum of Rs. 22,000 /-(twenty two thousand) and
    - iii) 02 (Two) Baofeng communication sets with charger.
- IV. In a follow up action of a ND&PS case FIR registered at Senapati-PS, Manipur Police arrested one Deep Jyoti Gogoi (32) of P/S Diyun, Changlang district from Arunachal Pradesh and was brought to Senapati-PS for further necessary action.
- V. Movement of **149** vehicles carrying essential items along NH-37 has been ensured. Strict security measures are taken up in all vulnerable locations and security convoy is provided in sensitive stretches to ensure free and safe movement of the vehicles.
- VI. A total of **111** Nakas/Check points were installed in different districts of Manipur, both in the hills and the valley.

VII. Appeal is made to public not to believe in rumour and be vigilant of false videos. The veracity of any circulation of unfounded videos, audio clips etc. may be confirmed from the number- **9233522822** of Central Control Room. Moreover, there are possibilities of many fake posts being circulated on social media. It is hereby cautioned that uploading and circulation of such fake posts on social media will attract legal action with consequences. Further, appeal is made to public to return the looted arms, ammunition and explosives to the police or nearest security forces immediately.
