Subject: Report regarding incident at Shangkai Village on 27/07/2026

Sir,

With due respect, I have the honour to submit the following report:

On 27/07/2026, I joined a convoy escort team from Yaingangpokpi carrying postal/courier items to be delivered to the Post Office, Ukhrul.

Upon reaching Shangkai Village, all vehicles in the convoy were stopped and checked by Kuki volunteers. At around 10:00 hrs, while the vehicles were detained, approximately 4 to 5 Kuki individuals armed with concealed weapons approached me. Three of them forcibly boarded my Post Office vehicle and compelled me to drive forward at gunpoint.

During this time, some security personnel inquired about our destination. The armed individuals threatened me, pressing a gun to my thigh and instructing me to remain silent. As such, I could not respond. They informed the security personnel that they were only going to offload courier items.

We were then driven to the Shangkai Village ground, where the courier items were unloaded. A total of 36 bags of courier items were set on fire and burnt by them. They also attempted to set the vehicle on fire.

However, some elderly persons who arrived in a black Alto car and a black Thar (registration number not known) intervened and prevented them from burning the vehicle. The elderly persons thereafter allowed me to leave.

The matter is reported for your kind information and necessary action.
